

2024–25 Night School is a Choice Program at Agassiz – FPS HS Students

Night School Campus: Agassiz Building - Room #311

1. Approximately half the FPS Night School class meetings are held in person at Agassiz. Attendance is required.
2. Approximately half the FPS Night School class meetings are held asynchronous virtual. The teacher is virtually available to help students. Students are required to do a virtual check-in as per teacher expectations.
3. Other Agassiz evening programs include GED, English Language Learner, Even Start and community sports.

Night School Format & Attendance

- FPS Night School classes are self-paced independent learning with teacher support and availability.
- Multiple courses in social studies or English meet in the same classroom and use Edmentum as a backbone to meet district and state standards. This flexible arrangement is beneficial.
- Super-block class nights @ 6:00-9:00 pm
 - On-campus dates are indicated in **bold** dates; attendance is required.
 - Asynchronous virtual dates are smaller font and not bold.
 - Asynchronous attendance: Students are expected to do a virtual check-in as per teacher’s expectation
- Seat time requirement: a student can complete the course after 13 class meetings
- Reporting. Power School is used for Nightly Attendance and Unit Grades and Final Grades
 - Edmentum progress and can be accessed by students, counselors, and administration.
 - Progress reports will be sent to your school and parents/guardian after the 4th, 8th, and 12th class.

Night School Student Expectations (Beyond attendance and punctuality)

- A. Come ready to work with a respectful and responsible attitude. Night School is a choice program!
- B. Closed campus. Once a student has arrived, he/she is expected to remain in the night school assigned area for the rest of the class meeting. If a student leaves the night school area without permission, they are not permitted to return to class for the rest of the given night class’ meeting.
- C. Snow days. Night school moves to virtual as per teacher’s direction. Work from home.
