The Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order by President Souders at 4:30 p.m.

D. Pledge of Allegiance

President Souders led the Pledge of Allegiance.

E. Closed Session

Clerk Clayton-Tarvin read aloud the item listed under Closed Session:

1. Government Code Section 54957: Public Employee Performance Evaluation - Superintendent

Trustee Westwell reported that a Brown Act violation is occurring pertaining to Assembly Bill 2449. President Souders stated that the District's legal counsel has reviewed the matter, including the concerns expressed at the last Board Meeting, and has advised that the District is not violating the Brown Act.

At this time, the following people spoke regarding the item listed under Closed Session:

Dana Arazi, parent, expressed ongoing concerns involving District inaction in addressing school site bullying and harassment among students; shared stories from other parents; commented on administrative leadership, including lack of enforcement of the District's anti-bullying policies at the sites; referenced a new website that he has started, with the goal of reducing bullying through community involvement; urged strong leadership at the top.

Randy Campbell, parent, discussed the lack of communication between the District and parents; spoke regarding the handling of the potential school site closures issue, noting a shadow closing of Village View is still apparent; questioned the District's legal counsel's advice; commented on the need for student discipline, as well as community-based leadership at the top.

Thao Vuong, parent, spoke about problems her son experienced at Mesa View Middle School involving bullying, sexual harassment, and retaliation; noted that school administrators are fabricating lies about her son, and urged consequences; questioned the District's anti-bullying policies at each school.

The Board of Trustees moved to Closed Session at 4:45 p.m.

The Board of Trustees reconvened in Open Session at 6:39 p.m. There were no Closed Session actions to report.


