Getting Started

Students begin with an adaptive placement test in the following subjects:

- Language (Grammar Skill)
- Math
- Vocabulary
- Foundational Reading
- Fact Fluency

View Placement Test Results by clicking on the module (listed above) and selecting the placement tab.

Things to Note:

- Placement tests begin at Kindergarten level and adapt as students answer questions correctly or incorrectly
- Moby Max will begin “filling gaps” with standards missed from placement test

Curriculum Settings

General

- Set the defaults for your classroom
 - o Homework Time
 - o Turn on/off Game Time
 - o Passing Score (default passing score is 70%)
 - o Teacher Notifications (Lesson topics failed, lessons completed, tests are failed)

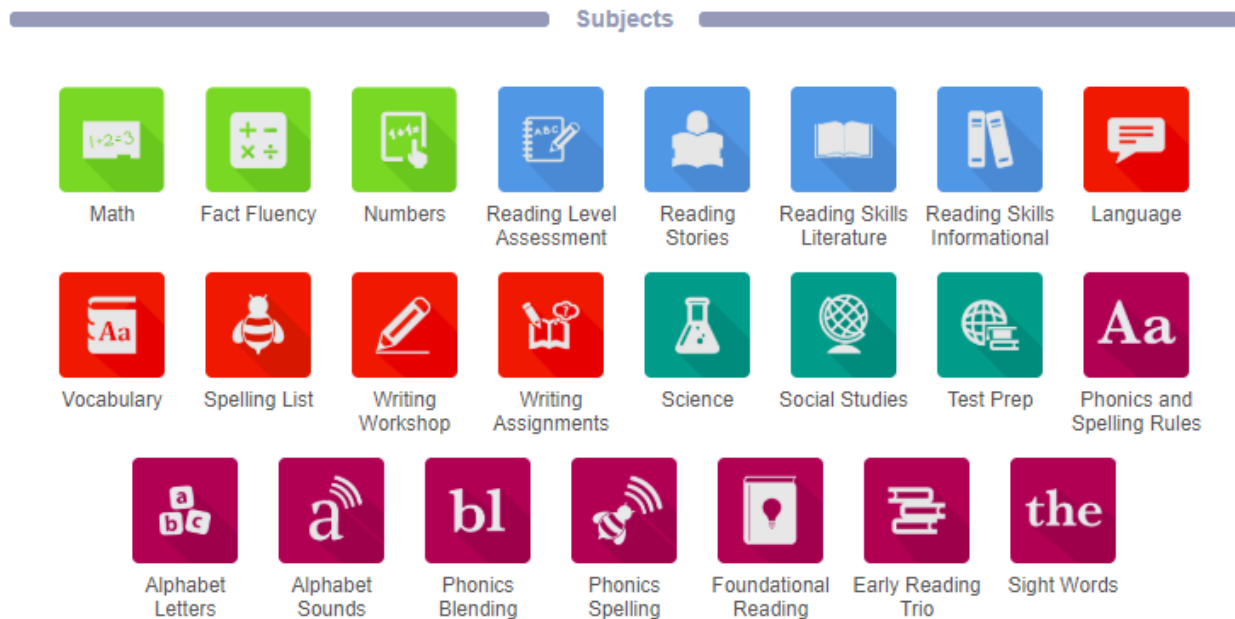
Modules

- Determine how long students are to work on each subject
- Start placement test at different grade level (Kindergarten is default)
- Set goals
- Hide modules

Things to Note:

- If you hide modules and share students with other teachers, they will be impacted by this change.
- Curriculum Settings can be changed for individual students or entire class.

Learning Modules



The Quick and Dirty:

- Purple Icons (Learning to Read)
 - o Early Reading Trio is Early Words, Early Reading, and Early Writing all rolled into one module
- Blue Icons (Reading to Learn)
 - o Reading Level Assessment is an independent module – great for getting a Grade Equivalent Reading Level (four tests versions available).
 - o Reading Stories develops comprehension through grade-level fiction and non-fiction texts. No lessons, just stories and questions
 - o Reading Skills gives practice on individual reading skills. Begins with a “Teach Me” lesson
 - o Foundational Reading starts with a placement test and is targeted for grades K-5. Focus in this module is on phonological and phonemic awareness, decoding, segmenting, blending, syllabication, etc.
- All icons begin on registered grade level except those that provide a placement test

Create a Group

Groups can be created to easily view data for or assign lessons to a specific sub-set of students.

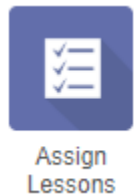
- Select *Roster*
- Select *Create or Edit Group* on right sidebar
- Create a group name and add students to the group making sure to click *Save*

Assign Lessons

Lessons can be assigned within each module or by selecting Assign Lessons on the Moby Learning Teacher Dashboard.

Directions to Use Assign Lessons Icon:

- Using the *Assign Lessons* icon, type the skill you want to assess or teach.
- Find the standard and select it by filling in the check box
- Complete the prompts and click *Assign*

Change Sequence

Because students are automatically assigned lessons, there may be times you want to be the first instruction on a concept. You can change the sequence by following the steps below:

- Select the module
- Select Lessons → Sequence
- Select the student
- Manipulate their sequence as you see fit

To view specific questions missed follow the directions below

- Select the module
- Select Lessons → Completed
- Select the student and then the lesson and click on blue tab
 - o This takes you to their final score on that standard. When clicking the final score in blue, you can view the specific question and the student response. It is from this screen you can easily re-assign the lesson.

Things to Note: You can view the class proficiency on a specific standard by selecting *Class View* in any module
