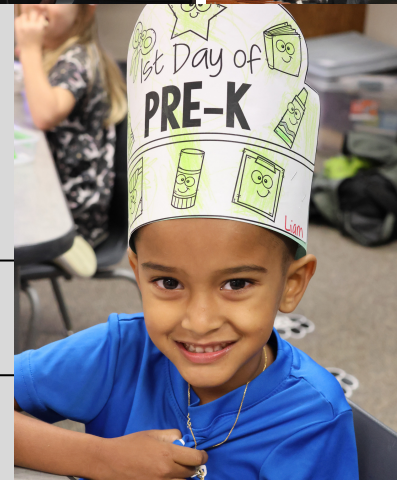

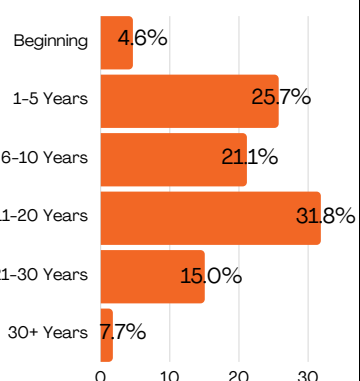
EXCEPTIONAL EXPERIENCES FOR STAFF



- Aledo ISD has its own police department dedicated to the safety and security of its staff and students. AISDPD has 13 staff members, 10 of whom are armed, experienced, highly trained police officers
- Last year, officers conducted more than 2,750 interior and exterior door-locked checks across the district (100% locked)
- New AISD Child Development Center opened in August 2022, offering child care to district employees

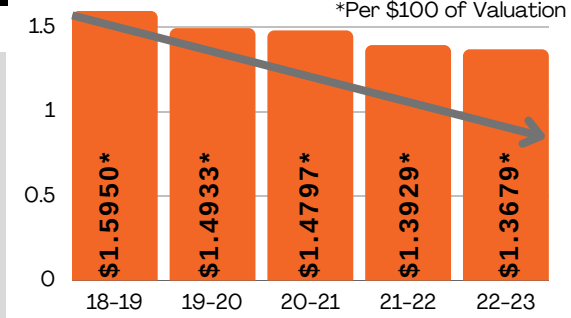

Overall AISD Tax Rate Decrease

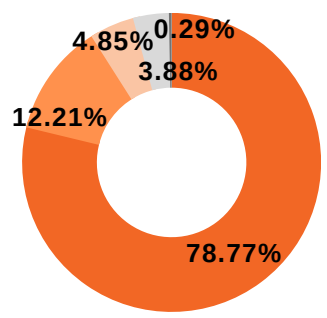

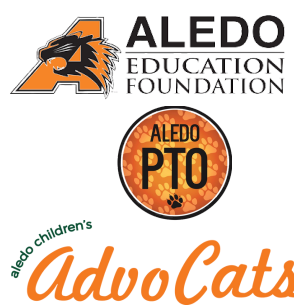

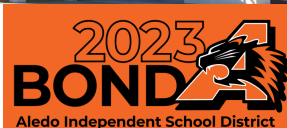

Aledo ISD wrapped up the **2019 Bond** by completing and opening for the 2022-2023 school year:

- New McNally Middle School
- Aledo Middle School Renovation/Expansion
- Vandagriff Elementary Relocation + Renovation/Expansion
- AISD Early Childhood Academy Renovation.

The community-led Aledo Growth Committee met from August through February to recommend the **2023 Bond** proposal to Trustees that voters approved in May 2023. Construction on Elementary School No. 7 (Lynn McKinney Elementary) began immediately.
