Acknowledgement of Rules for Approved Drones/UAS Use on DCSD Property

My signature below represents my acknowledgement that I understand the requirements of Superintendent File Policy KFAB and that Drone/Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) operation on district property requires the following:

- The Drone/UAS must be registered with the FAA and the pilot agrees to comply with all FAA Regulations.
- The Drone/UAS operator must be a trained pilot, agrees to keep the Drone/UAS within line of site at all times, and agrees to use spotters.
- The Drone/UAS operator will not fly over people or vehicles.
- The operator will not fly the Drone/UAS while under the influence of any substance.
- Drone/UAS operations will not interfere with any manned flight operation.
- Drone/UAS operations will not take place during adverse weather conditions.
- Compliance is required with all Federal and State laws, City and County ordinances, and any local noise ordinances.
- The operator will not fly the Drone/UAS where operations would violate the reasonable expectations of privacy.
- The operator attests that the Drone/UAS is in good condition and he or she has performed safety checks and taken precautions to ensure safe operations of the Drone/UAS.
- The operator acknowledges that all non-hobby use of a Drone/ UAS requires FAA authorization.
- The Drone/UAS will not collect any data that contains personally identifiable information.
- The Drone/UAS will not collect or transmit any data during CHSAA sanctioned events without CHSAA's written authorization in advance.
- Non-District use of a Drone/ UAS (other than by an individual hobbyist) requires advance approval of a DCSD Facility Use Contract and must comply with all requirements therein.
- The Drone/UAS operator acknowledges that DCSD provides no liability insurance for nonemployees or students. Likewise, there is no property coverage for damages caused by UAS.
- The Drone/UAS operator must carry a certificate of liability insurance with coverage amounts of \$2,000,000 per occurrence/ \$4,000,000 aggregate. Certificate of Insurance needs to name the District as an additional insured and a copy of the endorsement showing same must be included with the Certificate.
- The Drone/UAS operator agrees that any fines, penalties, and/or damages are the responsibility of the individual at fault.
- Independent contractors of Drones/UAS agree to indemnify and hold harmless DCSD, its officers, employees, students, volunteers, or agents for any loss, costs, damage, injury, liability, or third party action stemming from Drone/UAS operation.

- The Drone/UAS operator agrees to have his or her insurance company waive all rights of subrogation that the company may have against DCSD its officers, employees, students, volunteers, or agents.
