



District Sound & Light Technician

Purpose Statement

The role of the District Sound and Light Technician is to provide technical expertise and assistance in the use of theater facilities. This includes operating, repairing, maintaining, and rigging theatrical equipment to support staff, students, and community groups in theater productions.

Supervisory Relationship

Reports to: Building Activities Director at each high school

Essential Functions

- **Technical Advising:** Advise students, staff, and community clients on safety, facility maintenance, theater activities, and the use of theater equipment.
- **Client Assistance:** Assist clients in designing, implementing, and supporting lighting and sound technical needs for theater productions.
- **Equipment Operation:** Operate theatrical lighting and sound systems, including audio systems, specialized audio equipment, and digital lighting systems, to provide necessary support for productions.
- **System Design and Installation:** Design, adapt, and install theatrical lighting and sound systems to meet the technical needs of theater productions.
- **Maintenance:** Maintain tools and equipment to ensure they are available and in safe operating condition.
- **Adhere to School Policies:** Follow school policies and procedures.
- **Attendance:** This position requires prompt and consistent attendance.
- **Perform Other Duties:** Perform additional duties as assigned to support the effective operation of the work unit.

Job Requirements: Minimum Qualifications

Skills

- Proficiency in operating theatrical lighting and sound systems.
- Strong technical problem-solving abilities.
- Effective communication skills to advise and assist clients.

Knowledge

- Understanding of safety practices related to theater equipment and productions.
- Familiarity with various theatrical equipment and systems.

Abilities

- Work independently and as part of a team.
- Manage multiple tasks and prioritize work.
- Adapt to changing technical requirements and production needs.
- Communicate effectively with diverse groups and individuals.

Responsibility

Work under the supervision of the Building Activities Director to support theater operations. Provide technical support to ensure the success of theater productions. Utilize resources and maintain equipment to meet production needs.

Work Environment

Physical activities include lifting, carrying, pushing, and pulling theater equipment. Significant fine finger dexterity is required for operating technical equipment. The job requires working evenings and weekends on an as-needed basis. Work is performed in theater environments, which may include exposure to various lighting and sound levels.

Experience

Experience as a theater technician is required.

Education

Current high school student or community member with relevant experience.

Clearances

Criminal justice fingerprint/background clearance.
