## INTRODUCTION

The Academy for Health and Medical Sciences (AHMS) is a "school" within a school and is located at Somerset County Vocational and Technical High School. AHMS began in the 2006-2007 school year and the first Academy class graduated in the 2009-2010 school year. Students enter the ninth grade year as a cohort and progress through an intensive four year course of study sequence. The Academy for Health and Medical Sciences, in conjunction with Raritan Valley Community College, provides students with the opportunity to earn both a New Jersey high school diploma and an Associate's Degree in General Science. In order to remain in this highly specialized program, students need to maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher in all courses.

In the 2023-2024 school year, 25 students received degrees from Raritan Valley Community College. These 25 students also earned a high school diploma from Somerset County Vocational Technical High School.

## STUDENT SELECTION

Students in both Somerset and Hunterdon County may apply to the Academy for Health and Medical Sciences. Students are accepted into the Academy based on the following admissions criteria: 7th and 8th grade GPAs, 7th grade standardized test scores, admissions testing for mathematics, and language arts, and personal interview. Only students who meet a minimum point level are eligible for admission.
