



Rowland Hall Bus Rules

The bus is a continuation of the classroom; all Rowland Hall school rules apply to all students while riding a Rowland Hall bus. Students are expected to:

- Follow the driver's instructions the first time
- Show respect toward adults, other students, and school bus property
- Wear properly fastened seat belts
- Sit in assigned seats, if applicable
- Sit in their seats, facing forward, while the bus is in motion
- Talk quietly, using appropriate language
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to themselves and inside the bus
- Never throw anything out of bus windows
- Not bring electronic devices or phones on field trips
- Not eat food or chew gum on the bus

Lower School students may not use electronic devices on buses, whether on the Park City bus or the South Salt Lake bus (which is a mixed age bus).

Middle and Upper School students may use electronic devices on buses but all devices must be on silent or vibrate and used only in an emergency. (note: Middle School students may not use personal devices during the school day so we encourage students to leave devices at home)

If a student is not adhering to the above guidelines, the following consequences will occur:

- The initial infraction will be an opportunity to talk with the student(s) about the inappropriate behavior. The student(s) will receive a warning and be advised to change the behavior.
- If the inappropriate behavior continues after the initial warning, parents/caregivers will be contacted.

Consequences for continuing and/or serious infractions may include temporary or permanent loss of bus privileges.
