- Melissa Alfano questioned when parents will be notified if school does not reopen on October 5h.
- Andrew Coslit, SCVTEA president, requested the four-page letter sent from the SCVTEA to the board of education be read aloud as the superintendent's comments to the letter only show the superintendent's point of view. He also commented that teachers are not certified to clean and this responsibility should not fall on the teachers. He also questioned if transportation is ready; the School Based grant will continue and has concerns regarding the cancellation of the Integrated Technology Systems program and the employment of the teacher.
- Mr. Hyncik stated that personnel issues cannot be discussed during open session.
