2421.1. WORK/WORK-BASED LEARNING EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS

Date Created: June 2007

2421.1- WORK/WORK-BASED LEARNING EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS

Work-based learning Work-study program, in cooperation with business and industry, shall be provided as approved by the Board. The pupils students shall work only in approved job stations and shall be paid wages consistent with minimum wage pay rates. All State laws and regulations applying generally to employees and employers must be observed.

For all such training, pupils **students** must qualify in terms of skills and responsibility, according to standards set up by the program coordinator and guidance school counselor. At the high school level, they must have Pparental consent is needed if student is if under age 18.

The program coordinator shall approve workstations and employers, set conditions of employment, and determine hourly pay rates. He/she shall assign pupils students who qualify and who wish on the job training to particular jobs, and make such arrangements as necessary with employers for evaluating the pupil's student's job performance and for keeping records of his job attendance, performance, and earnings.

The coordinator shall report periodically to the Principal the cumulative earnings of pupils **students** in the program.

Transportation to job stations shall be the responsibility of the pupil student.

Outside Employment of Pupils Students

For full-time pupils **students** at the Somerset County Vocational and Technical High Schools, school responsibilities are to take precedence over non-school-related jobs.

If pupils students need to work while attending school, CIE Cooperative Education program personnel shall make efforts to help them obtain employment, preferably in an occupation related to their field of study. However, they shall be cautioned against assuming work commitments that will interfere with their studies and achievement in school.

2421.1. WORK/WORK-BASED LEARNING EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS

A. Cooperative Industrial Education (High School)

The Cooperative Industrial Education program provides individual training and work experience in a variety of skills. The program is open to seniors whose grades and attendance are reviewed by the CIE Cooperative Education Coordinator and recommended by the Career Major Instructor. (Juniors may be eligible under special circumstances.)

Pupils Students attend their academic classes and are assigned by the CIE Cooperative Education Coordinator to an approved school work station in place of shop their CTE program. Participation in the CIE Cooperative Education program can make vocational education more meaningful, will give credit towards graduation, and offers a head start towards a career.

The Cooperative Education program may extend past regular normal school hours and include Saturdays provided state and/or federal child labor law limitations are not exceeded.

B. Other Programs (Technology Institute)

On the job training of various types shall be required and/or made available to pupils in certain programs offered by the Technology Institute.

Clinical experience will be required of and must be successfully completed by pupils in the Allied Health Programs congruent with the requirements of the specific programs and/or regulating agency.

The Board shall approve in advance all agreements and arrangements with hospitals for providing clinical training for practical nursing pupils.

C. Work-Study (Technology Institute)

Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools participate in the federally-funded work study program, which provides qualifying pupils with part time jobs during the school year to help with educational expenses.

D. B. The School as a Site for On the Job Training

The County Vocational and Technical Schools may provide stations for on the job training in connection with such programs offered by the district itself or other organizations or agencies.
