SCVTHS Eligibility and Who The Program Applies To

- Students must be entering their Junior year
- Students must have completed two of the three necessary science courses for graduation with at least a 75% average
 - Earth and Space Science or Physics
 - Biology
 - Chemistry
- Students must be in good standing in their sending district
- Attend a SCVTHS/RVCC information session

RVCC Cosmetology Eligibility

- Must have obtained at least 575 hours from SCVTHS
- Students must have 80% average or greater from SCVTHS
- Students must maintain the minimum of 92% attendance rate yearly
- Submit RVCC application at the end of Junior year
- Meet placement requirements at the end of Junior year
 - Accuplacer
 - English 060
 - Math 020
- Complete a background check by December 1 Senior year
- Attend RVCC orientation June of Senior year

The Admissions Process: What does my sending school counselor need to submit to SCVTHS after I apply online?

- Official transcripts and report cards from Grade 9 and 10 (thus far)
- Standardized testing results (PARCC, NJASK, etc.)
- Review of discipline record
- Review of attendance record
- Testing accommodations if applicable

The Admissions Process: What do I do after my school counselor submits documents? **Not this year due to COVID**

- Once your application is submitted you will need to schedule a time for your Renaissance Star Admission Exam
 - www.scvths.org → Admission → Admissions Testing
 - Please note: If you require accommodations for state testing please make sure that we receive a copy prior to your scheduled testing date/time.
- Depending on enrollment a personal interview will take place

- Science (1 period)
 - Depending on the science you have already completed you would be placed in either:
 - Biology
 - Chemistry
 - Earth and Space Science

What is the content that will be covered in Cosmetology and the applied science for 12th grade?

- Year 2- Fundamentals of Cosmetology (2 periods)
 - Up-Do's
 - Wig and Hair Enhancements
 - Braiding and Hair Additions
 - Principles of Hair Design
 - Haircutting Level 1
 - Facial Makeup
 - Skin Structure, Growth, and Nutrition
 - Skin Disorders and Diseases
 - Electricity
 - Facials
 - Level 1 Haircoloring
- Science (1 period)
 - Anatomy and Physiology for Cosmetology

How does the program work during 11 and 12 grade at SCVTHS?

- During your 11th and 12th grade year, in addition to the content that is covered, you will create a portfolio that is shared with Ms. Bird at RVCC
- Students will have monthly benchmarks to achieve
- Ms. Bird will be on SCVTHS campus during 11 and 12 grade for check-ins
- During your senior year, you will be on the college campus 1 time a month and attend the RVCC cosmetology program

RVCC- A Look Ahead

- Students will transfer into the Advanced Course
 - 7 hours 5 days a week
 - Semester runs from July-November
- Salon Practicum
 - 100 hours in a program selected employer
- Cost:
 - SCVTHS Students pay current year tuition, materials and lab fees. A deposit of 50% of the tuition will be due by December 1st during the students Senior year at SCVTHS. The remainder along with material and lab fees will be due 30 days prior to the start of the RVCC Advanced course.

What is Included in my Cost of Tuition?

- Custom Materials
 - Uniform and Kit
- Practicum
 - Student/employer 4-6 weeks of an unpaid internship to make you career ready
- Additional Certifications
- Permit
- Assessment Fees
- 1st Year License
- Transportation to all trainings
- Acceptance of 575 hours from SCVTHS
 - SCVTHS students would be waived from the Foundation Course which is offered from February-June at RVCC
- Graduate with 1,200 hours

- Do what's best for YOU when making this decision to attend SCVTHS/RVCC Cosmetology program
- Have realistic goals
- Get to know your teachers and establish good relationships with them
- Talk to people outside the Cosmetology program
