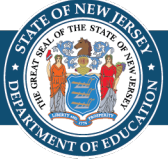

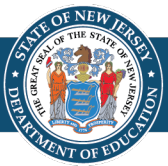

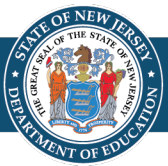


Comparison of Monroe Township School District's Spring 2022 and 2023 NJSLA Administrations Mathematics– Percentages (Levels 3 and 4)

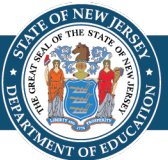


Comparison of Monroe Township School District's Spring 2022 and 2023 NJSLA Administrations Mathematics– Percentages (Level 5)

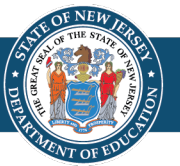
