Important Information for Visitors to Applegarth Elementary School

Our school district requires all visitors to identify themselves and state the purpose of their visit upon entering our buildings. Our Security Guard, Mr. Richard Stemming, will be at the front vestibule to assist and screen visitors. Visitors are required to sign in at the office and wear their visitor's badge in a prominent place on their person. Our staff has been instructed to question anyone who is not wearing a badge.

Anyone wishing to sign out a child during school hours must be authorized to do so and must properly identify themselves with a picture ID, such as a driver's license.

Custody Arrangements: There are many types of families in our community and our first and most important interest is in the safety and welfare of your child. If you are a family in which you, the parents, are either separated or divorced, it would be very helpful for us to have the proper legal court documentation in our files to adhere to the proper legal requirements of any agreements set forth by the court system. Please feel confident that all information will be kept in the strictest confidence and will only be available to those staff members making a decision on the release of your child to someone other than yourself. Please be sure that all the court agreements regarding custody are kept current in the school.

You have already received information from our Food Services Department regarding procedures and prices for the upcoming school year. The student lunch for this year will be \$2.65. Information Update

The Monroe Township School District will continue to use an automated communication system. This system enables the district and the school to dispense important information and notifications (e.g. school closings, delays, etc.) to staff, parents and students in a very short time frame – Blackboard Connect is the telephone message relay system we use. It is, therefore, very important for Emergency Forms to be reviewed and corrected. Please include your current address, home, cell, work and emergency telephone numbers. It is very important that we have up-to-date phone numbers and addresses in case of emergencies, both in our school records and for the Blackboard Connect Network. The Blackboard Connect program has the ability to send messages via text. If you would prefer to have a text message sent to your cell phone, please be sure that the primary phone number listed for your family is your cell number. The primary number for the Emergency and Verification forms you will be receiving should reflect your cell number.

A student drop-off lane is located at the end of the sidewalk on the right of the school, facing the school from Applegarth Road.

Zero Period For Advanced Instrumental Music And Chorus

Applegarth School will begin our programs for Zero Period Chorus and Band mid to late September. You will receive notification regarding the dates, days and times for Zero Period. Zero Period will begin the week of September 18th. Chorus will be held on Monday for Grade 5, Tuesday for Grade 4 and Friday Grades 4 & 5 will be on an alternating schedule. Wednesday and Thursday Zero Period will be held for Advanced Band students.

Beginning Band Instrumental Music

Students in grade 4 were given the opportunity to review various instruments at the end of grade 3. Students new to Applegarth School in grades 4 and 5 who are interested in participating in the school band will also have the opportunity to join the program. Mr. Ciarlariello will be available to meet with students interested in instrument instruction at the beginning of the school year and will provide the necessary paperwork to rent an instrument. The instruments are provided by and may be rented from Music & Arts. The instrumental band program will meet during the school day for individual and small group lesson instruction. Zero period rehearsals are only for students in the Advanced Band.

Our Winter Band/Chorus Concert will take place on Thursday, December 14th beginning at 7 PM at the Monroe Township High School Performing Arts Center. Performing students will travel to the high school the morning of Thursday, December 14th for a rehearsal. More information will be communicated as this date approaches.

School Bus Flashing Lights - Stop!

All residents are reminded that the state of New Jersey requires motor vehicles to **<u>stop</u>** when school buses are loading and unloading student passengers. School buses display red flashing lights whenever they pick-up or drop off students. Also, would you please share the following important rules with your child...



School Bus Safety Rules

- 1. Be on time.
- 2. Never run to or from the bus.
- 3. Stand back from the curb.
- 4. Don't push or shove.
- 5. Stay in your seat with your seat belt belted.

- 6. Don't yell or shout.
- 7. Always obey the driver.
- 8. Wait for the driver's signal before crossing.
- 9. Always cross at least 10 feet in front of the bus.
- 10. Never crawl under a school bus.

Please review with your child the bus rules as outlined in our Code of Conduct. Thank you.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR SCHOOL NURSE, MRS. ESSIG

Welcome back to Applegarth Elementary School. I hope everyone had a safe and relaxing summer. Please see below for some health office reminders for the upcoming school year.

Required Immunizations and Physicals

All new students transferring into Applegarth Elementary School from a private school or another school out of state will need a physical examination completed by their physician. Proof of the exam should be submitted as soon as possible. Physical forms as well as medication forms and asthma action plans can be found on the Applegarth School website on the nurse's page.

Screenings

I will be performing health screenings on all students over the course of the year which includes height, weight, blood pressure, vision, and scoliosis. The screenings done at each grade level are determined by state guidelines. I will notify parents of any discrepancies that I may find after screening each child.

Attendance

If your child will be absent, please enter the absence into the Parent Access symptom online. It is very important to include the reason for the absence on the Parent Access system for tracking and health purposes. If you do not report the absence, a school representative will call your home and emergency numbers to verify your child's safety.

Illness

Please keep your child home when they are sick. Students should not return to school until they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Motrin. If Covid-19 positive, please contact the school nurse. Please see the Applegarth School website for more specific guidelines for common childhood illnesses.

Medications

According to New Jersey State law, medications may not be given in the health office without a physician's order and parental consent. This includes Tylenol, Motrin, cough drops and cough medicine. Students also are not allowed to carry medication on their person or transport medication to school. Students determined to be capable of managing their own inhalers in school may carry their medication in school with a Self-Carry Order from their physician and parental permission. Self-carry medication order forms are available in the nurse's office or on the school website. Any medications that need to be kept at the school are required to be dropped off by a parent and have a doctor's note to accompany the medication. Food Allergies

There are many students with food allergies in our school. Please follow your teacher's guidelines when sending snacks into the classroom as many students have dairy, egg and nut allergies. The cafeteria is not nut free so you may send peanut butter in for your child's lunch. However, we ask that you avoid sending snacks into the classroom that contain nuts of any kind. Students requiring a nut free environment in the lunchroom are provided a safe, monitored place to enjoy their lunch upon parents request. Parents of students with food allergies can contact the Food Service Director Cindy Schaller at 732-521-6042 ext. 2042 for specific allergy information for foods available for purchase in the cafeteria.

New Jersey Family Care

New Jersey Family Care is available to eligible families needing insurance for their children. If you would like information regarding this or available Middlesex County based clinics for required immunizations or physicals, please call the health office for information.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding your child through the course of the year, please do not hesitate to call the Nurse's office and speak with me. Together, we can work out a plan to meet your child's needs in the school environment.

Potentially Disabled Students

The Monroe Township Public schools is again seeking to identify resident students between the ages of 3 and 21 who may exhibit difficulties with mobility, voice or hearing, visual acuity, physical limitations due to orthopedic or muscle abnormalities, cognitive, language or emotional difficulties. If you have identified a child who resides in Monroe Township with any one or a combination of difficulties listed above, please encourage the parent to contact the Department of Pupil Personnel Services at (609) 642-6128 to schedule an appointment. A member of the Child Study Team will initiate a referral for possible evaluation.
