DEFEATED 2009/10 SCHOOL BUDGET

Whereby, the 2009/10 Budget totals \$99,826,976; and

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT/RECOMMENDATIONS

Dr. Hamilton stated the following: "We've received several calls about the letter sent home this week and posted on our website as a precautionary measure. The media has done an exceptional job with providing information to the public, but it has also created some hysteria. Nonetheless, we received confirmation that the students involved tested negative for Swine Flu. The State Department of Education in conjunction with CDC has issued new information which advises schools against closure under most circumstances unless there is a pattern or cluster of illnesses. Which is not our case. In fact, our daily attendance is higher this week than it is ordinarily." Next, Dr. Hamilton expressed his congratulations to the "Teachers of the Year" that were recognized earlier. Then, Dr. Hamilton stated: "In absentia, I'd like to express my thanks and appreciation to Mayor Pucci and the Town Council for the manner in which the budget defeat was handled. Although it was a very uncomfortable position to be in, I thought the process was professional, productive and a clearly unified commitment to be responsive to the voice of the people but not dismantle or disrupt the programs and services provided to the children of Monroe. Dr. Hamilton then congratulated Mr. Leary, Mr. Braverman and Mr. Klein for a successful election to the Board of Education. Lastly, Dr. Hamilton stated that the District is working on preparation for the NJQSAC visitation and that the curriculum audit is complete, while developing a

cycle to have the updates completed by the time of the anticipated November visit, and conducting policy audits for this purpose.
