PRESENTATION ON DISTRICT GOALS

Dr. Kozak provided the Board and members of the public with a year-end report on the district goals. The presentation included roles of the superintendent; student academic achievements; staff recognitions; club and athletic accomplishments; community partnership and service; special education program review; and student data. The presentation also included a brief update/status on each of the following district goals along with the results of a district climate survey:

1. Initiate implementation and community-wide communication of district facilities planning in anticipation of increased enrollments;
2. Use targeted data to create a long-term plan based on the data analysis derived from the Special Education External Program Review; continue to analyze multiple data elements and identify areas of opportunity to improve individual student achievement; (identify achievement gaps, analyze benchmark data from NJDOE on 2016 PARCC results, and possible gaps between district schools)
3. Conduct in-district climate survey

Dr. Kozak stated that the climate survey indicated district staff are pleased with their employment.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Ken Chiarella, Chairperson of the Buildings, Grounds/Transportation Committee, stated that the committee met on May 1, 2017 and discussed the following:

A review of the annual IAQ Program review which the committee recommended to continue with the program as is.

A review of the Integrated Pest Management Plan. The Committee endorsed the plan as currently maintained and authorized proceeding with re-issuance of the Integrated Pest Management Plan for the 2017/2018 school year.

Administration reported that they applied for and were awarded an ERIC North safety grant in the amount of \$31,272.00 for the installation of safety surfacing at the Pre-K playground at Mill Lake School. Mr. Chiarella added that administration will look to undertake this project during the 2017/2018 school year.

Mr. Chiarella reported that the committee received an update of the proposed land transfer at Church Road, whereas administration advised that Brinkerhoff Environmental Services completed the first phase of Wetlands Mapping and is preparing a submission to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for a Letter of Interpretation. Additionally, the study for the protected and endangered species turtle will resume shortly as the breeding season is about to begin. Administration advised that the township engineer indicated that once Toll Brothers build-out of new homes at Colts Run is completed, the parcel of land will be transferred to the Township.

Lastly, Mr. Chiarella reported that the Committee requested that administration explore options for upgrading the old sound system used at board meetings as well as independent microphones for each board member.

Mr. Ken Chiarella, Chairperson of the Ad Hoc Committee for Fair Funding, reported that on May 2, 2017 some committee members and residents went to Trenton. Where Board President Kolupanowich was able to make a statement. Mr. Chiarella reported that they are still awaiting an outcome but the senators at the budget committee hearing seemed receptive. Mr. Chiarella added that this is a community effort and stated that he is appreciative of the partnership with the Township that has been created for this fair funding fight. Lastly, Mr. Chiarella reported that for exploratory purposes, he along with some committee members have met with other towns that are proceeding with law suits against the state.

Mr. Marvin Braverman, Chairperson of the Policy Committee, reported that the committee met on May 1, 2017 and spent the whole meeting discussing the health and Wellness Policy. Mr. Braverman reported that the committee will be discussing it again at the next meeting.

### PUBLIC FORUM

Chrissy Skurbe 21 Preakness Drive- asked the Board to reconsider the revisions in Policy # 167 / Public Participation in Board Meetings, specifically running the clock for four minutes and limiting a member of the public to speaking only once at each public forum. Regarding the summer reading list, Ms. Skurbe commended the Board and administration for removing the books Unwind and Looking for Alaska.

Parkash Parab 33 Dayna Drive – inquired how the students have performed on the SAT and AP Tests in the last three years and what the school ranking is. Mr. Parab stated that he will wait for the next meeting for the responses.

Andy Paluri 16 Saint James Street- stated that Dr. Kozak's management seems to be data driven, and Mr. Paluri suggested that a lot more can be learned by speaking personally with the students. Mr. Paluri also disagrees with the revision in Policy #167/ Public Participation in Board Meetings regarding limiting the number of times a member of the public can speak during public forum.

The vote included the Jamesburg Representative where appropriate. A copy of the Personnel section of the Superintendent's Report is attached to the official set of minutes.

Motion carried with Mr. Rutsky voting yes on Items B, E, F, G & H and abstaining on the remainder of the items. ### BOARD PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ms. Kolupanowich explained the superintendent's evaluation process. Ms. Kolupanowich stated that after Dr. Kozak completes his part, all non-conflicted members will be notified via email from New Jersey School Boards letting them know that the evaluation is ready for their input.

Ms. Koluhanowich stated that since Policy #167/Public Participation in Board Meetings has been revised and approved by the Board copies of the policy will be available at the next board of education meeting.

#### OTHER BOARD OF EDUCATION BUSINESS

Ms. Arminio reported that she attended a recent town council meeting, at which a first reading for an ordinance accepting block 52 lot 1.01(Rt. 522) transfer to Fire District #3 and a portion of that property to the Monroe Township Board of Education was presented. Ms. Arminio added that a second reading should occur at the next meeting and the public has the ability to attend and comment. Ms. Arminio added that the property in discussion is the property that Mr. Chiarella has previously reported on during the BG&T Committee Meeting reports.

Ms. DeMaio congratulated Mrs. Ariella Klein, Teacher of Chorus and the seven high school students that were accepted into the All State Chorus for 2017/2018; the 186 inductees into the National Honor Society and; the Teacher & Educational Services Professionals of the Year recipients for all they do for the district and students.

Ms. Lang reported and congratulated Mr. Edward Weiss, District Bus Driver for winning first place in the New Jersey Bus Safety Competition. Ms. Lang reported that she attend the NJSBA Middlesex County Meeting at which Mr. Marvin Braverman was recognized for his years of service to the Board of Education. Ms. Lang further reported that today the Clifton Board of Education put the NJ State Department of Education on notice that they were not going to send the additional two million dollars to cover the costs to send students to the iLearn Charter School. The Clifton district has realized an increase in the number of students (57 to 239) attending the iLearn Charter School. Ms. Lang added that Lakewood District sent letter to the State requesting ten million dollars to reach their Budget shortfall for 10 million shortfall.

Mr. Riback complimented Mr. Yale Snyder and the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Percussion Ensemble for the wonderful job they did this evening.

#### PUBLIC FORUM

Alexa Quarino 13 Fox Hunt Drive – spoke of and presented a petition requesting that the transfer of a custodian be revoked.

Prakash Parab 33 Dayna Drive – read a response that Senator Sweeney sent him. Mr. Parab inquired if funding is phased in the next five years with a 20% increase, how much funding the district can expect per year from the State. Mr. Parab also inquired about the School Funding Reform Act of 2008. Mr. Gorski explained that funding law, the adjustment aid and growth limits. Mr. Gorski added that the Ad Hoc Committee for Fair Funding is working to address these issues and Monroe's satisfaction will not come until a new funding formula is received.

Doug Poye 4 Tamarack Road – commended the Board for making sure that the past annual budgets included the funds for facility maintenance and improvement. Regarding the climate survey, Mr. Poye inquired if a survey was or has been conducted asking the parents how they think the district

and teachers are doing. Mr. Poye added that if it has not he would like to suggest that it be considered.


NEXT PUBLIC MEETING
