13. BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT/RECOMMENDATIONS

BOARD ACTION

A. PROFESSIONAL APPOINTMENTS

1. It is recommended that members of the Monroe Township Board of Education approve Silvergate Prep, 981 Route 22 West, Suite 202 Bridgewater, NJ 08807 to provide hospital educational services to students admitted into a hospital or treatment center at the rate of \$50.00 per hour for the 2014-2015 school year.

B. APPROVAL OF ADMINISTRATIVE AGENT FOR THE EDUCATIONAL COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM #26EDCP

It is recommended that members of the Monroe Township Board of Education approve Middlesex Regional Educational Services Commission (MRESC) to provide the services of Educational Data Services, Inc. the sole administrative agent for the Educational Cooperative Pricing System #26EDCP, to provide to the Monroe Township Board of Education, access to their proprietary software for the district’s use for items bid in the 2015-2016 school year as stated in the previously submitted agreement. The membership fee of \$9,112.50 is unchanged from last year. Participation in this program has saved the district \$1,520,849 accumulatively as opposed to procuring supplies under state contract or district bidding.

C. UTILITY BILL AUDIT AND COST RECOVERY AGREEMENT

It is recommended that the members of the Monroe Township Board of Education authorize and approve the previously submitted agreement through the districts consortium agreement with the Middlesex County Regional Educational Services Commission to participate with utility bill audit and cost recovery bid # MRESC 14/15-46, with Troy & Banks Utility and Telecommunication Consultants to conduct an audit or survey of the districts natural gas, electricity, street lighting, water, fire hydrants, sewage, landline telephone/data service, wireless telephone/data service, and cable TV (“Utility”) service accounts for the purpose of securing refunds and credits resulting from discovery of charges or costs in excess of those permitted or allowed by applicable contracts, tariffs, statutes, rules and regulations and/or from overcharges or billing errors. It is further recommended that for any refunds or credits obtained by Troy & Banks for prior overcharges, billing errors or costs in excess of those permitted by applicable contracts, tariffs, statutes, rules or regulations, Troy & Banks shall be paid 22% of all monies refunded or credited to the district.

D. E-RATE FUNDING

It is recommended that members of the Monroe Township Board of Education authorize On-Tech Consulting, Inc. to manage the E-Rate process for the 2015-2016 school year. The district will pay On-Tech Consulting, Inc. an amount equal to 15% of any funding received, either in the form of discounts from vendors or reimbursements from the USAC, through the Universal Service Fund program. There will be no out-of-pocket expenses or liabilities to the district.

E. RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR EXTRAORDINARY UNSPECIFIABLE SERVICES FOR A FIXED ASSETS INVENTORY

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(a) (2) provides that a board of education may award a contract for unspecifiable services without competitive bidding, provided that the board shall in each instance state supporting reasons for its action in the resolution awarding the contract; and

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Board of Education requires the services of an appraisal firm to perform and update a fixed assets inventory; and

WHEREAS, the need for expertise, extensive training and proven reputation is essential and the performance of the services could not be reasonably described by written specifications; and

WHEREAS, American Appraisal Associates agreed to work with staff to provide the development of detailed property records to support the capital asset reporting requirements of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement No. 34 (GASB 34); and

WHEREAS, American Appraisal Associates will provide an updated capital assets record to assist in regard to (a.) achieving property accountability and stewardship of assets, and (b.) to obtain a valuation of assets in compliance with the requirements of GAAP, GASB 34, and GAAFR; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Monroe Township Board of Education that it hereby awards a contract in the amount of \$15,000 to American Appraisal Associates in accordance with its written proposal as previously submitted. The rate has been negotiated to be unchanged from the previous year.

F. CONTRACT RENEWAL - HAULING COMMODITY

It is recommended that members of the Monroe Township Board of Education approve the previously submitted proposal with Paul's Commodity Hauling, Inc. for the 2015-2016 school year whereas Paul's Commodity Hauling, Inc. is a state authorized commodity delivery service and its services are necessary to participate in the commodity program.

* Any member of the public may record the proceedings of a public meeting of the Board in a manner that does not interrupt the proceedings, inhibit the conduct of the meeting, or distract Board Members or other observers present at the meeting.

The Board will permit the use of tape recorders, still or movie cameras, or videotape cameras only when notice of such intended use has been given to the Board Secretary one day in advance of the meeting. Any video recording device must be located and operated from inconspicuous locations in the meeting room as determined by the presiding officer of the meeting. The presiding officer may also limit the number of video recording devices if he/she determines the number and position of the video recording devices will be an unnecessary intrusion to the meeting. In this event, preference will be given based on the order in which prior notice requesting to record the meeting was provided to the Board Secretary.

The presiding officer shall determine when any recording device interferes with the conduct of a Board meeting and may order that an interfering device be removed.

** The Jamesburg Representative shall be eligible to vote on only those matters specifically designated in N.J.S.A 18A:38-8.1, as follows:

- (1) Tuition to be charged the sending district by the receiving district and the bill lists or contracts for the purchase, operation or maintenance of facilities, equipment and instructional materials to be used in the education of the pupils of the sending district.
- (2) New capital construction to be utilized by sending district pupils.
- (3) Appointment, transfer or removal of teaching staff members providing services to pupils of the sending district, including any teaching staff member who is a member of the receiving district's central administrative staff; and
- (4) Addition or deletion of curricular and extracurricular programs involving pupils of the sending district.

To the extent the Jamesburg Representative inadvertently votes on any other matter, his vote shall not be counted.

*** Public discussion is confined to this portion of the Agenda unless permission is granted by the Board President prior to the start of the meeting or when the Board is considering a Special Agenda Item that the Board deems appropriate for public participation. Anyone wishing to address the Board is requested to stand and state his/her name and address.
