Compulsory Extras

Examination fees. These are payable in the year exams are sat and vary depending on the number and level of examinations

Other incidental costs are charged in arrears for the previous term.

Stonyhurst has arranged for a number of experts to provide tuition in Tennis, LAMDA, Music materials and similar activities. The costs for these activities shall be notified in advance and billed usually in arrears for the term.

All pupils will need to purchase a school uniform through our supplier, Stevensons.

Payment Options

All fees for UK parents and overseas parents resident in the UK or with a UK bank account will need to be settled by on or before the start of term, unless an alternative payment arrangement is in place. Interest of 3% above the Bank of England base rate will be applied on a day to day basis for late payment with a minimum charge of £35.

Instalment arrangements

Termly fees can be settled in equal payments across the first three months of each term by arrangement with the Accounts Office.

Payments in advance

A discount is offered for fees paid in advance, the current rates are 2.5% discount for 4 or more terms paid in advance. 1 % for less than 4 terms. Please note that the fees are subject to annual review and any shortfall would have to be settled. Changes of Boarding Status

A full term’s notice in writing to the Headmaster is required before a pupil’s boarding status can be changed for either school.

Withdrawal of pupils

A full term’s notice in writing to the Headmaster is required before a pupil is removed from either school, failing which a full term’s fees are payable in lieu.
