- Speaking of...these are your families for your entire time at Rhodes!

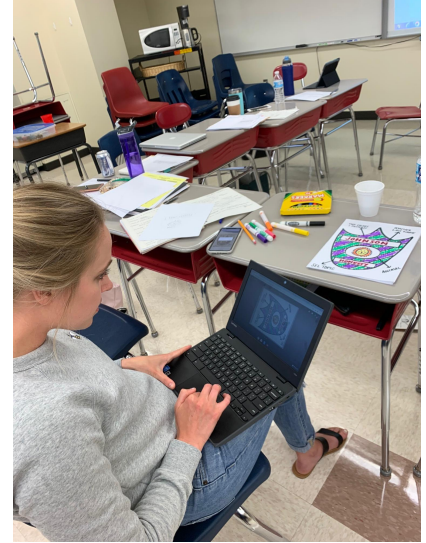
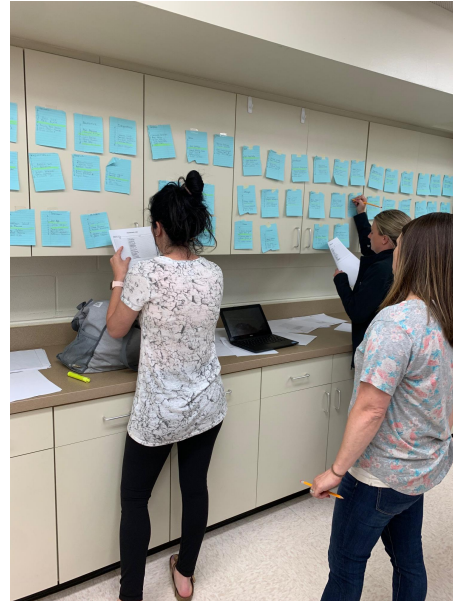
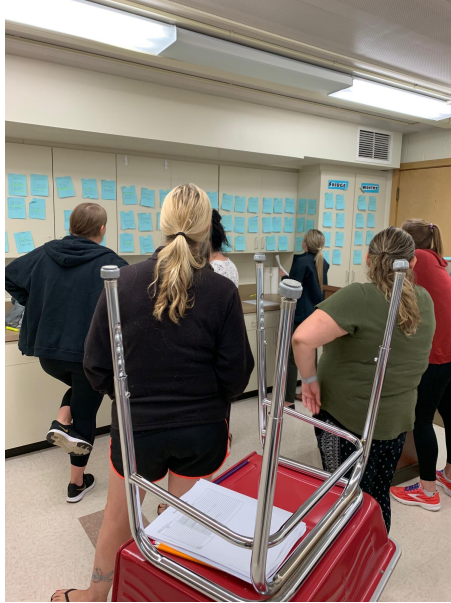
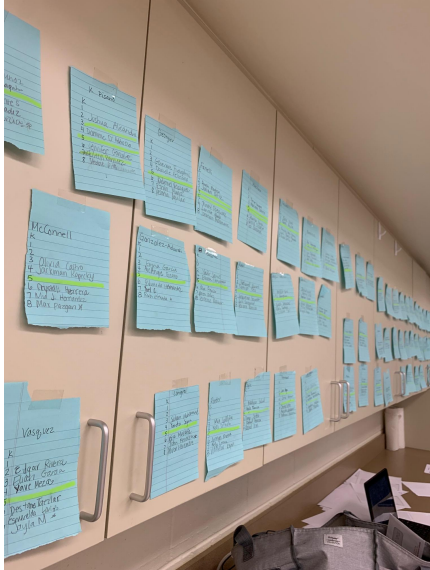
What we need from our middle school students:

 - 7th graders will help 2nd and 3rd grade students
 - 6th graders will help 4th and 5th grade students (if needed)
 - If a family doesn't have each of those grade levels the parent will figure out the best plan

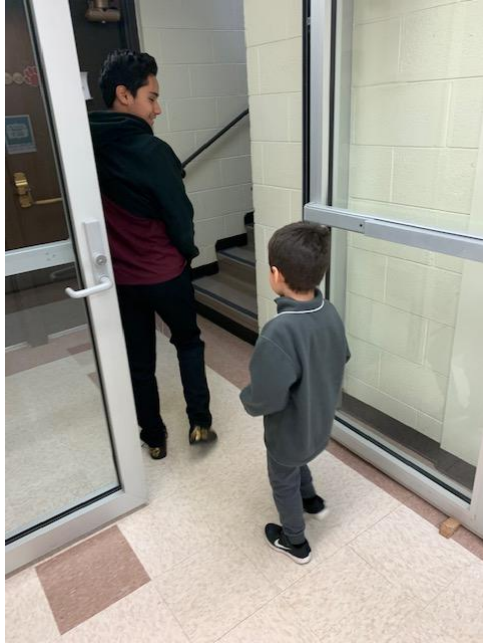
With Remote Learning in 2020-2021...
