Re: Student Services Report

The Student Services update tracks activity for special education aides, preschool enrollment, contracted services, out of district tuitions, and transportation.

The current forecast for aides includes seven vacancies which are in the process of being filled. All of the vacancies are expected to be filled based on changes in need for services pending receipt of signed/accepted IEPs. The forecast for aides projects a total deficit of \$117,346.

Currently, there are 165 students in out of district placements including 36 for whom we have agreements with parents. There are currently eight pending placements. In the month of January, one student was placed out of district, and one parent agreement ended at the high school level. One new parent agreement was reached, and one student was placed out of district at the middle school level. There was no movement at the elementary level, and one student was placed out of district at the Preschool level. The projection for tuition shows a surplus of \$87,701.

The Newton Early Childhood Program (NECP) currently serves 228 students. There are currently 83 students with special needs enrolled in preschool classrooms, 75 students who are typically developing enrolled in preschool classrooms, and 70 students with special needs receiving related services only.

The forecast for contracted services projects to be under plan for FY16.

There are a total of 470 students receiving Special Education Transportation. The number of students receiving out of district special education transportation is 119, and the number of students receiving in district special education transportation is 351. The forecast for transportation projects to be under plan by \$90,700.
