Jointly Developed

Together, parents, students and staff of RM Moore Elementary School developed and revised this School-Parent Compact for achievement. Teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added ideas about the types of support they needed and students told us what would help them learn.

Meetings are held each year in the spring to review the Compact and make changes based on student needs and School Improvement Goals. Parents are invited to attend and are welcome to contribute comments or suggestions at any time. Parents may also provide feedback through an online form. Additionally, parents are encouraged to participate in the Annual Title I Parent Survey that is used as a tool to collect parent feedback regarding current Title I programs.

District Goals

Our District's goals for achievement for the 2024-2025 school year are:

- 1. Increase the average scale score in ELA, math, science and social studies by four points annually.
- 2. Increase the graduation rate of students in underperforming subgroups by 1% annually.

School Goals

Staff at RM Moore Elementary School have studied student performance data and decided on important areas of improvement for our school. The School Goals for the 2024-2025 school year are:

- Increase by 3 percentage points the number of K-2 students scoring at or above grade level expectations on the District Reading Assessment and the number of 3-5 students scoring at the proficient or distinguished level in ELA on the GA Milestones Assessment by May 2025.
- Increase by 3 percentage points the number of K-2 students scoring at or above grade level expectations on iReady Math Diagnostic and the number of 3-5 students scoring at the proficient or distinguished level in math on the GA Milestones Assessment by May 2025.
- Increase by 3 percentage points the number of 5th grade students scoring at the proficient or distinguished level in science on the GA Milestones Assessment by May 2025.
- 4. Increase by 3 percentage points the number of 5th grade students scoring at the meets or exceeds level in social studies on the Common Social Studies Benchmark Assessment by May 2025.

- 2. Mathematics: number sense, visual representation, place value and problem-solving.

Teachers will work with students and their families to support student growth and academic success by:

- Regularly pull data and update individualized Data Goal Sheets to share with students and families to monitor growth in ELA and Math.
- Create and share ELA and Math resources with families.
 Model the use of resources with students.
- Provide appropriate leveled texts for students to read at home.

Parent Responsibilities

Parents can participate in their children's learning and academic growth by:

- Monitor student progress through Data Goal Sheets in ELA and Math.
- Utilize ELA and Math resources with students at home to practice/improve their skills.
- Read leveled texts weekly with my student.

Student Responsibilities

Students can maximize success and reach their learning targets by:

- Work with my teacher(s) to update my Data Goal Sheets to check my ELA and Math progress.
- Practice skills utilizing ELA and Math resources at home at least two nights a week.
- Read leveled texts for 20 minutes nightly.
