



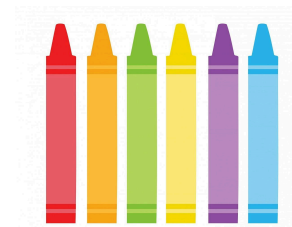
## Welcome to TK

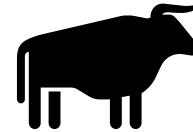

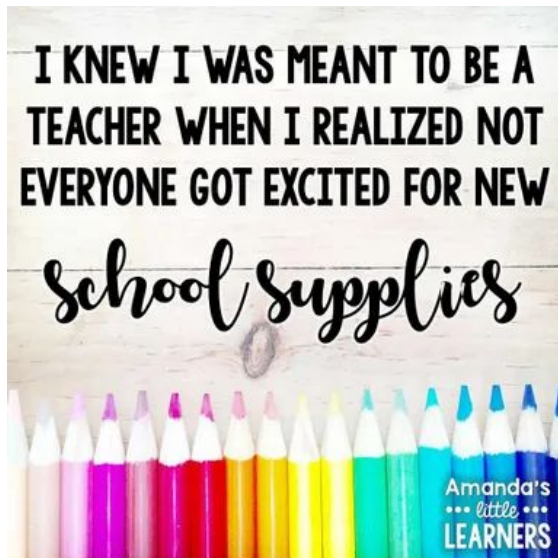

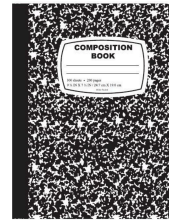
