PUBLIC COMMENT SIGN-UP SHEET

Audience participation at regular Board meetings is encouraged. If you wish to address the Board please complete this form, providing all information requested, and hand it to the Board Secretary, Katherine Springer, prior to the Board Meeting start time.

In accordance with BED(LOCAL), persons wishing to address the Board about a topic related to District business during the period reserved for public comment at a Board meeting must sign up to be heard. [See BED(LOCAL)] The following guidelines apply to public comment:

1. Each participant will be limited to three (3) minutes to make comments to the Board. This time may be adjusted as discussed in Board Policy BED (LOCAL), but will not be less than 1 minute.
2. The period reserved for public comment at a Board meeting will be limited to sixty (60) minutes for any non-agenda items.
3. Under the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board is not permitted to discuss or act upon any issues that are not posted on the agenda for tonight's meeting.
4. The Board has adopted complaint policies that are designed to secure, at the lowest possible administrative level, a prompt and equitable resolution of complaints and concerns. Each of these processes provides that, if a resolution cannot be achieved administratively, the person may appeal the administrative decision to the Board as a properly posted agenda item. For further information on those policies, please contact Lynn McKinney, Deputy Superintendent, at 817-441-8327. If the subject of your comment involves a pending grievance, you are encouraged to seek resolution through the grievance process and address the Board at the appropriate stage of that process.
5. Under the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Board may exercise its authority to discuss certain subject matters in closed session, including matters involving individual District staff members and individual students. If your comment concerns one of these subjects, please address your concern through the District's complaint policies.
6. Finally, please be aware that rules of decorum will be enforced during the public comment period. Personal attacks, name-calling, and rude or slanderous remarks will not be tolerated. Each participant is legally responsible for the content and consequences of his or her own statements.
