



2024-2025 CCA SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE

CCA has partnered with J&R Uniforms and Land's End Uniforms to supply our student uniforms. All uniform pieces, including khaki and navy pieces, must be purchased through these vendors.

Logos or monograms will be applied to all uniform pieces, so uniform pieces ***MUST*** be purchased through the school's approved vendor. Clothing worn to school without the monogram or logo will not meet dress code requirements. This is to ensure that colors, design, style, and fit are consistent for a uniform appearance among all students. Also, all pieces are made wrinkle and shrink resistant for easier care and better student presentation.

IMPORTANT NOTE: CCA has decided that the 2024-2025 school year will be a transitional year for uniforms and will allow students to wear uniforms purchased during previous years that still fit (jackets, polo shirts, etc). This is to provide a grace period to those parents that recently purchased Coweta Charter Academy uniforms so that they will not incur an unnecessary expense for the current school year.

VERY IMPORTANT: If purchasing online, ORDER USING SIZE CHARTS PROVIDED THROUGH THE VENDOR.

For specific functions/events the school will require students to wear specific uniform pieces. BELOW ARE THE **REQUIRED UNIFORM PIECES** THAT ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE:

- 1) WHITE OXFORD SHIRT or WHITE PETER PAN BLOUSE
- 2) Grades K-4 RED Full Zip or 1/4 Zip Light Weight Jacket, Sweater, or Cardigan
- 3) Grades 5-8 NAVY Full Zip or 1/4 Zip Light Weight Jacket, Sweater, or Cardigan
- 4) Grades K-4 RED Polo
- 5) Grades 5-8 NAVY Polo
- 6) Grades 5-8 APPROVED PLAID or NAVY Tie
- 7) Grades K-5 P.E. Athletic Shirt & Shorts and/or track suit
- 8) Grades 6-8 P.E. Athletic Shirt & Shorts and/or track suit (*Note: P.E. attire is only required if the Grades 6-8 student is planning to take P.E. as a middle school elective*)

Students are expected to wear the CCA uniform at all times and to dress and groom themselves in such a way as to reflect neatness, cleanliness, and safety. All students should dress appropriately so as not to disrupt or interfere with the educational program or the orderly operation of the school.

A School Director or the Superintendent shall determine whether any particular mode of dress, grooming, and/or accessories is in violation of the spirit and/or the intent of the school's dress code policy. Students and parents are expected to honor the uniform code in order that valuable school time is not spent examining student attire to determine appropriateness.

Students are not permitted to change out of their uniforms during or after school unless participating in P.E. or an after school activity that requires non-uniform clothing.

CCA will contact the parents/guardians of students that are in violation of the school's dress code policies, so that they can bring an appropriate change of clothing to the school. Students in violation of dress code policies will be seated in the front office until an appropriate change of clothing is received for the student to change into. **Inappropriate attire jeopardizes the instructional climate and will not be accepted.**

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES FOR CLARIFICATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Uniforms must be worn properly at all times while at CCA:

- a. Students must be in complete uniform when they arrive at CCA. All shirts must be tucked in shorts, pants, or skirts. Belts must be worn with all pants and shorts with belt loops. Belts are not required for Kindergarten through 2nd grade students. Uniforms are expected to remain intact and appropriately worn throughout the entire day at school.
- b. Students must remain in full uniform until after they leave CCA. Shirts must remain tucked in – even after school, until they leave the school campus.

2. Shoes, Shoelaces, & Socks/Hosiery:

- a. Shoes must be closed toed shoes or boots, only solid black, solid brown, solid red, or solid navy in color, OR athletic/tennis shoes in red, navy, black, or white. Athletic shoes must be predominately red, navy, black or white with no designs ...small logos are fine (i.e. Nike swoosh). No special designs or patterns (checkered, plaid, camouflage, etc.) or wild colors are permitted. **Shoes must be worn at all times.**
- b. An emphasis regarding shoes is safety – for that reason, all shoelaces must be tied properly, all buckles fastened, all straps must be secured or velcroed – nothing may dangle or drag from the shoe.
- c. Flip-flops, Crocs, Slippers, Clogs, open-heeled shoes, and high-heeled shoes are not permitted
- d. Heels on shoes may not be higher than one (1) inch. *Special Event Exception Note: Dress shoes for dances, picture days, or other school events may not have heels exceeding two (2) inches.*
- e. Character, Sparkly (Glitter/Rhinestones), and Roller (“Wheelies”) shoes are not permitted. Note: Kindergarten through 2nd grade students ARE ALLOWED to wear character shoes.
- f. Shoelaces must be solid brown, black, navy, red, or white.
- g. Socks, Tights, Stockings, or Hosiery MUST be worn with shoes. SEE ACCESSORIES FOR SPECIFIC DETAILS

3. Pants or Shorts:

- a. Pants and shorts in khaki or navy. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. These will have the school initials on them. 3rd through 8th grade pants and shorts have belt loops. A belt must be worn at all times with pants and shorts that have belt loops. If a belt is required, it must pass through all the loops and be fastened appropriately. Kindergarten through 2nd grade students’ shorts and pants may not have belt loops, so they are not required to wear belts.
 - Pants and shorts must be worn properly at the waist and not sag below the top of the hips. Pants or shorts may not be rolled up or folded up. Shorts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee and not longer than the top of the knee when standing. Capri style pants are not acceptable. Pants or shorts must not be overly form-fitting. Students wearing the top of their pants or shorts below their waist will be given a **Disciplinary Referral Form** for improper exposure and required to adjust their uniform.
- b. P.E. Athletic Shorts in navy (permitted only during P.E. or approved physical activity). Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor and have the CCA monogram. These are the only athletic shorts that may be worn for P.E. and/or approved school physical activities. Shorts may not be rolled up or folded up. Students wearing the top of their shorts below their waist will be given a **Disciplinary Referral Form** for improper exposure and required to adjust their uniform.
- c. P.E. Athletic Pants in navy (permitted only on P.E. days or for approved physical activity). Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor and have the CCA monogram. These are the only athletic pants that may be worn for P.E. and/or approved school physical activities. The athletic pants match the P.E. Athletic Jacket. Pants may not be rolled up or folded up. Students wearing the top of their pants or shorts below their waist will be given a **Disciplinary Referral Form** for improper exposure and required to adjust their uniform.

4. Jumpers (Kindergarten through 4th grade only):

- a. Jumpers in khaki, navy, and the approved plaid are permitted for grades Kindergarten through 4th. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. The jumpers will have the school logo on the front. The jumper’s bottom hem must at least align with the tip of your middle finger when arms are at your side. Modesty Shorts (purchased through uniform vendor), bike shorts, or a cheerleading short in navy or red MUST be worn with all jumpers. Shorts must be worn even if the student is wearing tights. If the jumper is too short or the student does not wear shorts under their jumper, the student will be given a **Disciplinary Referral Form** for improper exposure and parents will be called to bring shorts or other clothes to the school.
- b. Pants, jeans, pajama bottoms, or other apparel **may not** be worn under the jumper. For modesty purposes, shorts MUST be worn under the jumpers, however, long pants, jeans, pajama bottoms, or other apparel showing

below the jumper are not permitted. (Note: If preferred, leggings in red, navy, or white are permitted in place of shorts under jumpers for K-4th grade students.

5. Polo Dresses (Kindergarten through 4th grade only):

- a. Polo dresses in red or navy are permitted for grades K – 4th. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. These may have short or long sleeves. The dresses will have the school logo on the front. The dress's bottom hem must at least align with the tip of your middle finger when arms are at your side. Modesty Shorts (purchased through uniform vendor), bike shorts, or a cheerleading short in navy or red **MUST** be worn with all dresses. Shorts must be worn even if the student is wearing tights. If they are too short or the student does not wear shorts under their dress, the student will be given a **Disciplinary Referral Form** for improper exposure and parents will be called to bring shorts or other clothes to the school.
- b. Pants, jeans, pajama bottoms, or other apparel **may not** be worn under the jumper. For modesty purposes, shorts **MUST** be worn under the dresses, however, long pants, jeans, pajama bottoms, or other apparel showing below the dresses are not permitted. (Note: If preferred, leggings in red, navy, or white are permitted in place of shorts under dresses for K-4th grade students.

6. Skorts (skirts with attached shorts):

- a. Skorts (skirts with attached shorts) in khaki, navy, or the approved plaid are permitted for grades K – 8th. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. These will have the school initials embroidered on them. Skorts must not be rolled or folded at the waistband.
- b. Skirts are not permitted, unless as allowed in item c. below.
- c. A calf or ankle length skirt in khaki or navy is available through a special vendor for students in grades 5-8 concerned with more coverage for modesty or religious reasons. Please contact Ms. Lassetter for how to special order this uniform piece. These will have the school initials embroidered on them.

7. Shirt Options:

- a. Oxford Shirts in white or light blue. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. Shirts may either be short sleeve or long sleeve with CCA school initials or logo on the pocket. All shirts and blouses must be tucked in (front and back; able to see the entire belt/entire waistband) at all times to the short, pants, or skort the student is wearing.
 - NOTE: Oxford Shirts, if not wearing a tie, must be worn buttoned up to second from top.
- b. Blouses with a Peter Pan collar in white (permitted for K through 4th grade girls only.) Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. Blouses may either be short sleeve or long sleeve with the CCA school logo or initials. All shirts and blouses must be tucked in (front and back; able to see the entire belt/entire waistband) at all times to the short, pants, or skort the student is wearing.
 - NOTE: Blouses, if not wearing a tie, must be worn buttoned up to second from top.
- c. Polo Knit Shirt in *pique, smooth, or performance fabric (quick dry material)* in red, navy, or white. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. These knit shirts are short or long sleeve with the school logo. All knit shirts must be tucked in (front and back; able to see the entire belt/entire waistband) at all times to the short, pants, or skort the student is wearing.
 - NOTE: Polo knit shirts must have at least have the bottom button buttoned at all times.
 - Grades K - 4th – RED Only
 - Grades 5th – 8th – NAVY or WHITE Only
- d. Turtle Neck or Mock Turtle Neck shirts in red, navy, or white. These shirts are long sleeve. If the student wears the turtle neck or mock turtle neck as their main outermost top garment it **MUST** be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor and have the school logo embroidered on it. If the student wears the turtle neck or mock turtle neck **UNDER** a pullover sweater or jumper, then it is not required to have the school logo as the outer garment will have the logo embroidered on it – in these cases it may be purchased from anywhere. All shirts must be tucked in (front and back; able to see the entire belt/entire waistband) at all times to the short, pants, or skort the student is wearing. For grades 5-8, these may only be worn under a sweater or sweatshirt.
 - Grades K-4 RED Only – if worn as main outermost top garment
 - ALL Grades may wear RED, NAVY, or WHITE if it is worn under a pullover sweater or jumper
- e. P.E. Crewneck Sweatshirt in gray, red, or navy (permitted only during P.E. or approved physical activity). Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. Sweatshirts are long sleeve with the school monogram and are the only sweatshirt that may be worn for P.E. and/or approved school physical activities.

- Grades K - 4th – RED or GRAY Only
 - Grades 5th – 8th – NAVY or GRAY Only
- f. P.E. Short Sleeve Shirt in gray, red, or navy (permitted only during P.E. or approved physical activity). Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. These shirts are short or long sleeve with the school monogram and are the only shirt that may be worn for P.E. and/or approved school physical activities.
- Grades K - 4th – RED or GRAY Only
 - Grades 5th – 8th – NAVY or GRAY Only
- g. CCA Spirit Wear and Academic Team Shirts or Sweatshirts are purchased through the school. Spirit Wear and Academic Team Shirts must be tucked in (front and back; able to see the entire belt/entire waistband) at all times to the shorts, pants, or skirt the student is wearing. Spirit Wear and Academic Team Shirts can be worn ONLY on approved days.

8. Sweaters, Cardigans, Half-zip Pullover, Full-zip Jackets, and Athletic Jackets:

- a. Sweaters, Cardigans, and Sleeveless Sweater Shells in navy, red, or white. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. All sweaters and cardigans have the school logo. The sweaters are v or crew neck pullovers and the cardigans have buttons down the front. Both the sweaters and cardigans require that the student must still be wearing a CCA shirt underneath – the sweaters or cardigan cannot be worn alone as a top. Sweaters and cardigans may not be worn tied around the waist or shoulders.
- Grades K - 4th – RED Only
 - Grades 5th – 8th – NAVY Only
- b. Quarter-Zip Pullover or Full Zip Lightweight Jacket in navy or red. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. The Pullover or Jacket has the school logo. The pullover or jacket requires that the student must still be wearing an CCA shirt underneath – the pullover or jacket cannot be worn alone as a top. The pullover or jacket may not be worn tied around the waist or shoulders.
- Grades K – 4th RED Only* (*for the 24-25 school year, navy jackets with the old logo are permitted)
 - Grades 5th - 8th NAVY Only
- c. P.E. Athletic Jacket in navy (permitted only on P.E. days or approved physical activity). Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. This jacket has the school logo. This is the only jacket approved for P.E. and/or approved school physical activity. It matches the P.E. Athletic Pants. The student must still wear a CCA P.E. shirt underneath – *the athletic jacket cannot be worn alone as a top.* The athletic jacket may not be worn tied around the waist or shoulders. The athletic jacket may only be worn with the P.E. Shorts or P.E. Pants.

9. Accessories:

- a. Belts must be solid leather, braided leather, or fabric in the solid colors of black, brown, red, navy, or white. Belts MUST be worn with all pants and shorts that have belt loops. Grommets, brads, or excessive ornamentation on the belt is not permitted. Belts are required to be worn properly with all pants or shorts – this means that the belt must go through all the belt loops on the pants, be properly fastened or buckled, and the “end” of the belt must not be allowed to hang down (it must also go through the loops if there is excess). The belt must also be tightened enough to prohibit the student’s pants or shorts from sagging below the waist. Kindergarten through 2nd grade students are not required to wear belts.
- b. Socks should only be solid white, solid khaki, solid red, solid navy, or solid black. Brightly colored or printed socks will not be permitted. Socks styles may be no show, fold down, crew, or knee socks. Over-the-knee-socks are not permitted.
- c. Tights must be solid white, navy, khaki, or red. Tights must cover the full length of the student’s legs and feet. Leg warmers and leggings** are not permitted. (**K-4th grade students may wear leggings in solid white, navy, or red with jumpers instead of tights.)
- d. Stockings or hosiery must be white, navy, or match the student’s natural skin tone. Hosiery must not be patterned and must be footed. Stockings or hosiery must cover the full length of the student’s legs and feet. Thigh high hosiery is not permitted. Leg warmers and leggings are not permitted. No-show footlet hosiery may be worn with ballet flats.
- e. Ties in navy or the approved Plaid. Must be purchased through the CCA approved uniform vendor. Ties are available in three styles: pre-tied, self-tie, and cross tie (girls). Ties may be worn with oxford shirts and peter pan collared blouses.
- f. Hair Accessories. These must coordinate with the school colors of red, navy, white, approved Plaid, and/or khaki. Gold and silver may also be worn. All hair accessories should be appropriate for school and not attract undue attention or pose a safety risk.

- g. Head Scarves may be worn for religious observance only. These must coordinate with the school colors of navy, red, white, approved Plaid, and/or khaki. They should be appropriate for school and not attract undue attention.
- h. Jewelry should be appropriate for school and not attract undue attention or pose a safety risk. Jewelry should coordinate with the school uniform. Long dangling earrings are not permitted for safety reasons.
- i. **Smart Watches ARE NOT allowed. These are prohibited at all times and should be left at home.**

Miscellaneous Guidelines:

- a. Clothing should be neat, clean, and wrinkle-free.
- b. Clothing with rips, tears, holes, and/or frayed edges is considered inappropriate for school.
- c. Clothing may not be worn inside out or backwards.
- d. Proper undergarments/ foundational garments are required at all times. (i.e. boxers, briefs, underwear, panties, bras, camisoles, etc. as is applicable) Undergarments must not be exposed.
- e. Athletic outfits are not permitted in the school building, except for days that P.E. classes are scheduled and on Dress Down Days provided they fall within the Non-uniform Apparel Code requirements. Only the approved P.E. Athletic Uniform may be worn in place of the regular school uniform for P.E. and/or for other approved school physical activities.
 - i. Kindergarten through 4th grades may wear their P.E. uniform to school on the days they are scheduled to have P.E. class. Note: Students are allowed to wear their regular school uniform to P.E. classes, as well. Students WILL NOT be permitted to change clothes (dress out) at school.
 - ii. 5th grade may wear their P.E. uniform everyday as they shall be scheduled to have P.E. classes five (5) days a week. Note: Students are allowed to wear their regular school uniform to P.E. classes. Students WILL NOT be permitted to change clothes (dress out) at school.
 - iii. 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students may wear their P.E. uniform everyday IF they have chosen P.E. as an elective. These students will have P.E. classes five (5) days a week. Note: Students are allowed to wear their regular school uniform to P.E. classes, as well. Students WILL NOT be permitted to change clothes (dress out) at school.
- f. Hats, caps, visors, curlers, head scarves (other than for religious reasons), bandanas, doo-rags, pics, combs, sweatbands, chains, sunglasses, gloves, leg warmers, arm warmers, and hooded garments are not to be worn during school hours and/or at afterschool activities.
- g. Outdoor coats are not to be worn in the school building. They are only to be worn outside and must be removed once a student is in the building and stored away in a place designated by their teacher.
- h. Rain coats/jackets are not to be worn in the school building. They are only to be worn outside and must be removed once a student is in the building and stored away in a place designated by their teacher.
- i. Hair, face, and body paint unless specifically approved for a school activity are inappropriate for school and are not permitted.
- j. Hair Styles that are distracting or extreme are not permitted. (i.e. mohawks, liberty spikes, etc.)
- k. Hair and Facial Hair must be groomed, neat, and well-kept.
- l. Cosmetics/Make-up should be age appropriate, appropriate for school, and not attract undue attention.
- m. Tattoos, temporary tattoos***, and henna are prohibited. (***)Temporary tattoos may be allowed for class parties and/or as part of an approved school activity at the discretion of the teacher.)
- n. Piercings other than earrings are prohibited.
- o. Clothing that is revealing, such as mini-skirts, short-shorts (shorts with a 1" to 3" inseam), spaghetti straps, tank tops, low-cut blouses (reveal cleavage), halter tops, mesh shirts, and/or shirts exposing any part of the midriff, back, or shoulders are not to be worn to school. Tight and extremely form-fitting clothing is also considered revealing and may not be worn to school. Sleeveless shirts are not allowed. This section mainly applies to non-uniform days at school.
 - i. **EXCEPTION: Clothes, specifically dresses, dressy tops, dressy skirts, and dressy pants for school dances or other fancy dress-up non-uniform events have the following requirements/guidelines separate from the Non-Uniform Apparel Code:**
 1. Spaghetti straps are allowed provided that when a student leans over their top remains in place against their chest.

2. The dressy garments may expose parts of the back and/or shoulders depending on the style of dress or dressy top. However, fully backless garments ARE NOT allowed.
 3. The midriff/stomach area must be fully covered at all times.
 4. Cut-outs and see through material are not allowed except in the area of the back, upper chest, and shoulders.
 5. Necklines should not expose cleavage.
 6. ALL dresses must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
 7. Appropriate undergarments must be worn.
 8. No undergarments may be showing.
 9. The styles worn should be age appropriate
 10. The clothes worn should be appropriate for the occasion/event.
 11. Students wearing dresses above the knee are required to also wear modesty shorts, bike shorts, Spanx, or cheer shorts under their skirts/dresses as many of the current dances or moves students engage in involve students dropping down, spinning, and/or bending over.
 12. Shoes may not have more than a 2" heel and it is highly encouraged that they have an ankle strap.
 13. If wearing a suit jacket or coat a shirt must also be worn. The shirt must not be see-through or have cut-outs.
 14. All shirts must have no more than two (2) buttons undone.
 15. All other non-uniform dress code rules apply if not specifically written in this section.
- p. All t-shirts must be in good taste. No suggestive wording, illustrations, logos, and/or advertisements for items which are illegal or prohibited for students - i.e., alcohol and tobacco products, vaping, etc. (Mainly applies to non-uniform days at school). Administration approved school spirit t-shirts may be worn in lieu of school uniform shirts on approved days.
- q. All outside coats, jackets, and/or hooded apparel may not be worn inside the school building. All outside coats, jackets, and/or hooded apparel must be removed and put away immediately upon returning to the classroom or other area of the school building. The CCA uniform includes optional sweaters, cardigans, pullovers, turtle neck shirts, and mock turtle neck shirts for those students who need to have additional layers to remain warm. NOTE: As an exception to this rule, outdoor coats embroidered with the school logo and without hoods may be worn inside the school building.
