Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedures

Please use the below to familiarize yourself with our arrival and dismissal map. Parent parking will now be available in the front of the school beginning after the first bell at 7:25-2:15PM. Please note, at 2:15 we will cone off this entrance for parking to ensure safety bus loading procedures and timely bus departures.

Arrival Procedures: Students may enter through the North or South gate from 7:00-7:25 when the first bell rings. The playground will be closed to anyone other than staff and students.

Parent Walk-Up- You may park and walk your child to one of the gates if you wish. Please utilize the large parking lot and cross at the designated crosswalk circled in red on the map.

Parent Drive-Up- You may choose to drop your child off in the drive-up car lane. Please ensure you are waiting in line closest to the red curb and remaining in your vehicle until a staff member instructs you to release near the South Gate entrance. When exiting this parking lot **right turn only**.

Dismissal Procedures: Students will be exiting the building no earlier than 2:15PM. You may greet your child at the parent waiting area or in your car.

Parent Walk-Up- You may park and meet your child at the designated parent waiting area. Please wait in the drive-up line and utilize the large parking lot once able.

Parent Drive-Up- You may choose to pick up your child in the drive-up car lane. Please display your name plate in your passenger window at all times. Remain in your vehicle until a staff member instructs you to stop near the South Gate entrance. When exiting this parking lot **right turn only**.

Welcome Back Families,

Please take the time to review and read the information below pertaining to your student and medication policies here at school.

Medication

Health Office staff administer over-the-counter and prescription medication in the school setting in accordance with Governing Board policy (Policy 5-404).

The following is required:

- All medication must be brought to the Health Office and picked up from the Health Office by an adult. Students should not carry medications to and from school.
- Up to a 30-day supply will be accepted.
- A consent form for administering prescription and nonprescription medications must be completed and signed by a physician, nurse practitioner or physician's assistant for all medications administered at school, except for emergency administration pursuant to A.R.S. §15-157 (Epinephrine auto-injector) or A.R.S. § 15-158 (Inhalers) or A.R.S. § 15-341, subsection A, paragraph 43, (naloxone hydrochloride/any other opioid antagonist). Parent/Guardian signature is required for both prescription and non-prescription medication per the Kyrene Family Handbook 2024-2025, page 7.
- Sample prescription medication must be accompanied by a prescription. Only medications that are needed to treat an existing ailment will be stored in the Health Office.
- Expired medications will not be administered.
- The Arizona Department of Health Services will not allow preschool children to receive stock medications of any form.
- A consent form for administering prescription and nonprescription medications must be submitted for administration of non-prescription medications beyond a three- consecutive-day period to ensure medications are not masking the symptoms of a serious health condition.
- A student may carry and self-administer an inhaler or epinephrine device with proper labeling and written parental permission. Students should report to an adult or to the Health Office after use.
- School Health Offices DO NOT stock aspirin, ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin), Benadryl, Hydrocortisone cream /or ointment, antibiotic ointment, cough drops or calamine lotion.
- School Health Offices will stock acetaminophen and dispense with parent/guardian permission for temperature 101°F and above.
- Medications will not be routinely dispensed to students during the first and last hour of the school day to minimize the possibility of drug overdose.

Kyrene schools offer nutritious meals at a low cost. Families seeking reduced-price or free meals must <u>submit an application</u> for assistance or visit <u>kyrene.org/foodservices</u> for more information.

Kyrene uses an online system for managing school meal accounts. If you do not already have an account, please visit the payment portal below to register. Meal account balances can be checked at any time through <u>LinqConnect.</u> Cash and checks made payable to Kyrene School District are accepted at school sites as well. Additionally, Kyrene meal prices will remain the same as the 2023-2024 school year. Regular meal prices: Lunch-\$3.00; Breakfast-\$1.70

Student Messages and Deliveries:

In an attempt to preserve instructional time, messages and deliveries for students will be held in the office and an email will be sent alerting the teacher that it is there. Teachers will send the student down during a break in instruction. If you have a change in transportation for your child, please send a note ahead of time with your child or, for last minute changes, contact the Colina office *PRIOR* to 1:45 pm.

Bus Information:

Kyrene is proud to provide transportation for students in an environment that is safe, courteous, and on time. Be sure to review the <u>Bus Rules</u> and expectations as well as our video reviewing seat belt usage during the bus ride.

Note: Even if your child rode the bus in the past, please check the online <u>transportation portal</u> to verify eligibility and bus stop locations!

As a reminder, kindergartners will not be released from the bus without a parent or guardian to pick them up.



Student Attendance

Regular attendance and punctual arrival at school are two habits that can positively impact student learning. Parents/guardians are urged to make every possible attempt to schedule doctor, dentist, and other appointments for students outside of the school day whenever possible. This will reinforce the importance of school and allow students to participate in all aspects of the school curriculum.

It is very important that the school be notified before 8:15 am, at the latest, if a child is going to be absent. Please call our 24-hour attendance line at (480) 541-2601 to report an absence. If the school has not been contacted by 8:15 our automated phone system will call all numbers on file to determine the reason for the absence. Absences will be excused for illness, medical or family emergencies, and appointments that cannot be scheduled after school hours. Please support your child by arriving to school on time every day.

Birthday Celebration Reminder

Colina School will be following the Kyrene School District guidelines on celebrating birthdays in school. Parents/guardians are not permitted to bring cupcakes, treats, cookies, balloons, or flowers to school. With prior approval of the classroom teacher, parents may share non-edible items such as pencils or stickers for a student's birthday. Each student has his/her name announced on their birthday as recognition of their special day!


