## THE PLAN...

### PREVENTION AND TRAINING

Drivers and attendants will be trained to utilize precorrection and preventative prompting to establish positive bus climate.

### INTERVENTION AND COACHING

Drivers will use positive intervention strategies when faced with misconduct and document appropriately.

### CAMPUS COLLABORATION

If the misconduct continues, transportation staff will work with the campus to deliver discipline to address the behavior.

### SAFE Bus Expectations

<b>S</b> SHOW RESPECT	APPROPRIATE VOICE LEVEL HANDS AND FEET TO SELF USE POSITIVE SCHOOL LANGUAGE BACKPACK AND BELONGINGS IN YOUR LAP
<b>A</b> ACT ACCOUNTABLE	BAUSE ON AND OFF SIT AND REMAIN IN YOUR ASSIGNED SEAT GET ON/OFF AT CORRECT STOP SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING
<b>F</b> FOLLOW DIRECTIONS	ENTER AND EXIT THE BUS APPROPRIATELY WEAR YOUR SEATBELT DO WHAT THE DRIVER INSTRUCTS NO FOOD OR DRINK ON THE BUS
<b>E</b> ENCOURAGE KINDNESS	SPEAK KIND WORDS TO EACH OTHER BE HELPFUL PRACTICE COMPASSION BE A POSITIVE LEADER

## BUS CONDUCT

### BUS CONDUCT REFERRALS

- Incident reasons aligned with SAFE Expectations
- Written to mirror the code of conduct and E-school incident codes
- Parent letter in Bus Conduct
- SAFE Bus Expectations for Parents

### THREE DOCUMENTED INTERVENTIONS

Drivers will document 3 interventions in Bus Conduct for Level 1 misconduct. This documentation will be sent along with campus referral if 4th is written.

### RE-TEACH LESSONS

Transportation will provide intervention lessons that can be used to reteach and reinforce bus expectations. These can be used by the campus in DMC or detention.



## WORKING TOGETHER TO PROMOTE SAFETY

### SUPERVISORS AND CAMPUS ADMIN

Creates a common language and aligned expectations for follow through and consistency.



### BUS CONDUCT RUBRIC

#### LEVEL I LEVEL II LEVEL III

- Modeled after the Student Code of Conduct
- Guidelines... not written in stone.
- Focus is teaching and changing behavior, not punishing kids and parents.
