Tutoring for Pay

In accordance with standard professional ethics, no teacher shall teach privately (tutor) students of any school where such teacher has classes. This shall not apply to teachers of homebound children employed by the Board of Education.

The instruction of students in a teacher's class shall be part of his/her regular duty. These students shall be entitled to all the reasonable amount of time that is needed or can be given to them.

The use of school buildings will not be permitted for tutoring on a fee basis.
