Employee Safety

The New London Board of Education is required to inform employees and prospective employees of the existence of any work-related conditions or hazards which may cause birth defects or constitute a hazard to an individual's reproductive system or to a fetus. Further, the New London Board of Education is required to inform staff members of any chemicals, toxic or radioactive materials, or other substances used in connection with Board of Education activities which the Board should reasonably believe may cause birth defects or constitute a hazard to an individual's reproductive system or to a fetus.

It is the policy of the Board that reasonable measures are to be taken to protect all employees from exposure to such hazards should they be identified.

To this end, any employee or prospective employee who is aware of or has concerns about the existence of hazards and materials within the above definition should immediately call such concerns to the attention of the Superintendent of Schools or to his or her designee.
