## A YES VOTE TYPICALLY MEANS THAT A VOTER SUPPORTS BALLOT PROPOSAL. IS THAT THE

CASE IN THIS ELECTION?

The YES, non-homestead operating millage generates approximately \$32.7 million annually, and the hold harmless generates approximately \$9.8 million annually. Together they generate approximately \$42.5 million annually. This is 22% of the school district's operating budget. Taxes WILL NOT increase for residents.



## DO I NEED TO REGISTER TO VOTE OR GET AN ABSENTEE BALLOT?

You need to update your voter registration if you have changed your name or address since the last time you voted. You can do this at any Secretary of State Office or local clerk's office. All voters have the option to vote absentee. Request an absentee ballot at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/ or from your local clerks office.



## WHO CAN VOTE IN THE NOVEMBER 5 ELECTION?
