Signing In & Out

Students who are enrolled in Community School & Intramural Sports will be dismissed from their class directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the class/sport begins. The instructor/coach will pick up your child from Kid Power and escort them to their designated area for their afterschool class. Once the class is over, please meet your child at the lower school front lobby doors for pick up. Students who do not get picked up after their class is over will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily aftercare rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's LMP tuition account.

Payment, Cancellation, and Refund Policy

- Pay with your debit or credit card directly through your Finalsite Billing Management Account. Transaction fee will apply.
- Payments are due at least one week prior to the start of the program. Parents are responsible for the entire amount of each program.
- If LMP can not physically open its doors due to acts of God or health & safety reasons, parents will not be responsible for the unattended week. If make-up classes are required during the season, parents will be notified accordingly.
- If a parent wishes to cancel their child's registration, a request must be given via email at least one week before the start of the class/sport to the Afterschool Activities Director. A confirmation will be given once your cancellation has been successfully made. If the registration is not canceled by one week before the start of the 1st day of the Community School / Intramural Sports, the full fee is due even if the registered child does not attend. In addition, if you choose to have your child miss a class, if your child is absent, or if you pull your child out of the class once the program begins, you are still responsible for 100% of the fees.
- If the child is not eligible to return to Community School / Intramural Sports due to long term sickness or injury, the determination for a refund will be given by the Afterschool Activities Director and/or the business office.
