Science	Activity Description <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water Solutions Directions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For this experiment you will need 4 clear cups with water in them, two teaspoons of salt, two teaspoons of baking soda, two teaspoons of sugar, and some small objects to try and drop in the solutions (little jewels, dimes, small grapes, little legos, etc.). Dissolve two tablespoons of salt in one cup, two tablespoons of baking soda in another cup, and two tablespoons of sugar in a third cup. Make sure to leave one cup as just plain water. Make sure you label each cup so that you stay organized! Now predict whether the small objects will sink or float in each cup. After you predict, drop your objects into each cup to see if you were correct! What happened and why do you think that?
