



## Senior Painted Parking Spaces



**WHO:** Seniors Only

**WHY:** To beautify the campus, to build school spirit, to create a senior tradition.

**HOW MUCH?:** \$40 to paint your parking space (does not include permit, paint, or supplies). Make Checks payable to Butler High School.

### THE PROCESS:

- Step 1: **Purchase a student parking permit first**, and then purchase a Painted Parking Space. (Please note, student parking is limited and permits are available on a first-come, first-served basis.)
- **Step 2: Submit a copy of your design, signed painting contract, and cash/check to Mr. Longley in the front office (pages 2 and 3 of this document) in person or by email (kevin.longley@vbaviators.com), by 3:00 pm on Tuesday August 13th. Spaces will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. (if you have late arrival, your spot will be on the south side of the SAC).**
- Step 3: Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email (at the email address you provide on the Design Request Form) letting you know if it is approved, unacceptable, or if any changes need to be made.
- Step 4: You will attend 2 designated painting days to complete your painting. Supervised painting will take place on **August 15<sup>th</sup> and August 16<sup>th</sup> from 9am-2pm**. If you paint after hours, please have an adult present.

### PAINT REQUIREMENTS:

- Paint must be water-based exterior latex. **NO OIL-BASED PAINT!** It is suggested that you speak with the paint supplier's paint department about what you are doing, how much paint you will need, and color selection. **NOTE:** *If you use oil-based paint that will not be able to be removed or causes damage, you will be held financially responsible for the repairs.*
- No spray paint or paint sprayers, reflective paint, fluorescent paint, or clear coat permitted.
- You will provide your own paint, brushes, tape etc. (Consider sharing with others.)

### PROHIBITED:

- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.
- No negative or rude language (Be nice).
- No "gang-style tagging."
- No double meanings.
- No flags.
- No political statements, messages, or symbols.
- Must be school-appropriate and follow all Butler handbook guidelines to be consistent with VBCSD parameters. We reserve the right to deny any painting request we feel does not reflect the spirit of our school.
- You may include your name but no one else's name. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. (A boyfriend's or girlfriend's name is NOT allowed.)

If you paint any prohibited items in your space, you will paint over the parking space, may face disciplinary action, and you may forfeit your parking permit with no refund.

### PAINTED PARKING SPOT CONTRACT

I have read the school rules regarding painted parking and hereby agree to abide by these rules and regulations. I will complete my painting during the designated painting days only.

If I do not abide by any of these rules:

- I will forfeit my painting privilege.
- I will paint over my spot (and purchase the paint necessary to do so).
- My parking permit may be voided at school discretion without refund.

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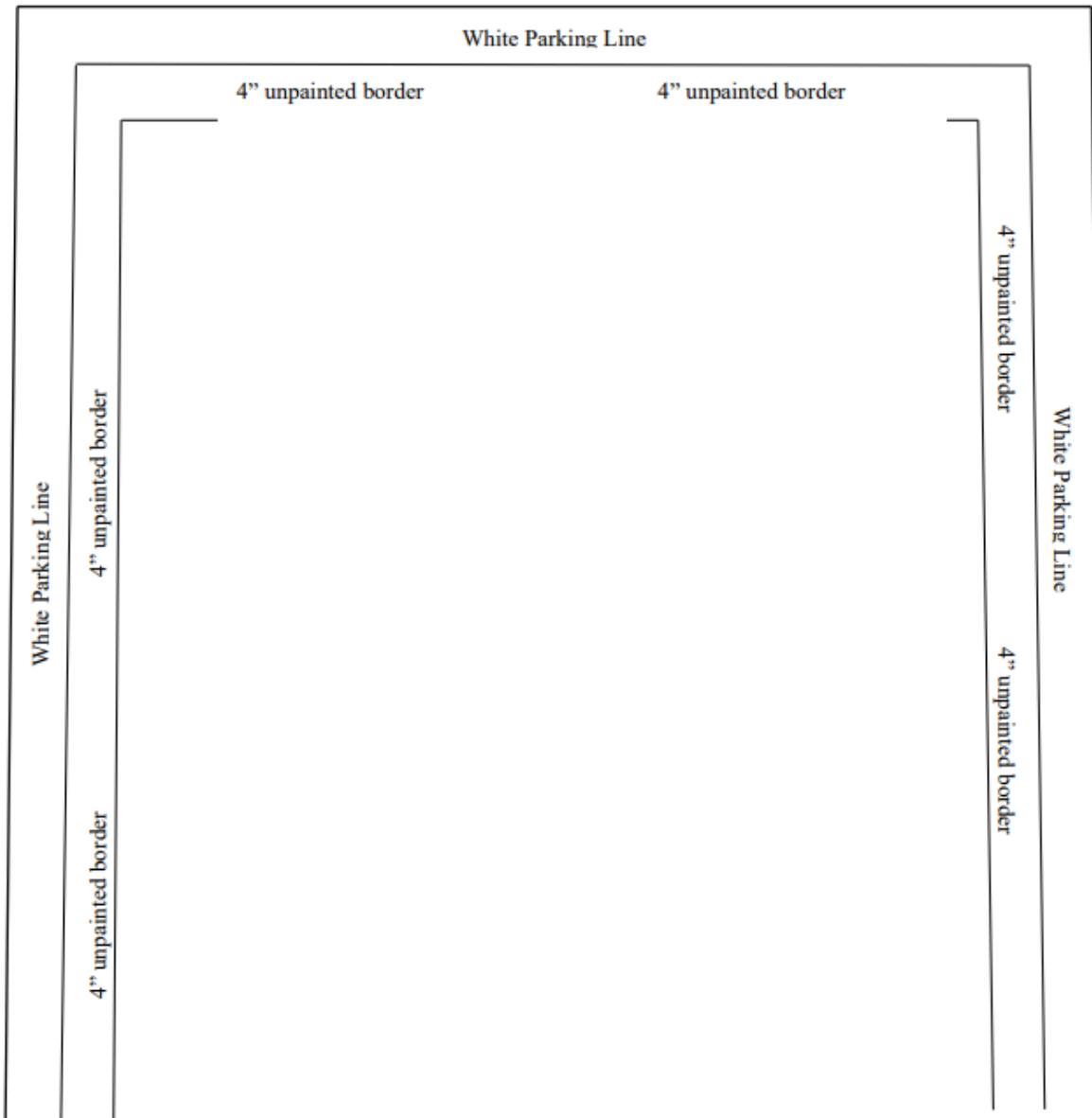


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### Senior Parking Design Request

The design must fit within the parking space dimensions, 4 inches from white lines on each side. Do not paint over the number in your parking spot.

Sketch your design below in color to represent exactly what you will be painting.



Explain below what this design represents or means:

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### ON THE PAINTING DAYS:

Please show up on time and focus on finishing your spot. Consider bringing friends to help speed up the painting process as it can be very tedious and laborious.

### WHAT YOU NEED:

- Your copy of your approved design – so you will have your approved template to follow. You must follow this design exactly – no changes allowed.
- A broom to sweep off your spot before painting. (A battery-powered leaf blower works even better).
- Chalk to sketch out your design.
- Paint, paintbrushes, rollers, paint trays (rollers for “rough surface” work best), painter’s tape, tape measure, garbage bags for trash/clean-up.
- A blanket or cardboard to kneel/sit on while painting. The pavement is hot!
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans.
- Shade structure will be helpful.
- Lots of water and Gatorade/sports drink.

### THE PROCESS:

1: Check in with the school supervisor and get your paint approved.

2: Clean off your space. Using tape measure and painter’s tape, tape the edges to mark 4 inches from white lines.

3: Paint your spot.

4: Clean up. Place all garbage in garbage bags, tie them shut, and drop them in the dumpsters as you exit campus. Leftover paint or supplies you want to reuse, need to be placed in garbage bags and taken home. There is no hose or washing station available at the school for cleanup.
