Outerwear

• No outerwear should be worn in the buildings (including jean jackets).

Tops

- •School appropriate logos are permitted.
- Hooded sweatshirts are allowed to be worn, but hoods are not to be worn over the head.
- Tops cannot be sheer or sleeveless.
- No crop tops are permitted. (There should be no gap between a student's shirt/sweatshirt/sweater and pants/shorts/skirts.)

Bottoms

- •While a student is standing and arms extended straight down, the length of a student's shorts, skirt, or dress must be below the fingertips. No tears or rips in any clothing if above the fingertip length.
- Cargo pockets are not permitted.

Shoes

- Closed toe and heel for students at JSC (due to stairs and playground).
- No bedroom slippers or shoes with wheels are permitted in any building.
- No heels greater than 2 inches high are allowed in any building.

Other

- Clothing that references drugs, alcohol, sex, or gangs is prohibited.
- Jewelry and belts that could be dangerous, such as wallet chains, dog collars, spiked necklaces, spiked bracelets, spiked belts, spiked earrings, or jewelry/belts that contain studs or rivets are prohibited.
- Students are not permitted to wear headgear of any type (with the exception of barrettes, or accessorized headbands or religious wear) including but not limited to hats, bandanas, hair picks, sweatbands, and hoods.
- Sunglasses are not permitted to be worn in the buildings unless required by a medical doctor.
- Accessories or piercings deemed to be dangerous, distractive, disruptive, or offensive in nature are prohibited.
- Tattoos that are deemed by administration to be offensive or vulgar, contain sexual references, or are likely to lead to substantial disruption or distraction to the educational process in school are not permitted.
- No excessively loose or tight-fitting clothing.

Consequences

- First violation warning and change to appropriate clothing
- Second violation recess, lunch, or afterschool detention and change to appropriate clothing
- Third violation after-school detention or in-school-suspension and change to appropriate clothing
- Refusal to adhere to the dress code may result in further disciplinary consequences as determined by building administration.

Verification of Residency and Eligibility for Educational Services

Please carefully review the following items that may impact your child's eligibility to attend school in the Pottsville Area School district.

You or your child has moved:

If you or your child has moved or will be moving anytime to a different location within PASD, you must immediately notify your child's school regarding your current address and continued eligibility to attend PASD. You must provide three (3) proofs of residency to your child's school in your name with new address. Failure to do so may result in your child's withdrawal from school and legal proceedings against you to recover tuition and other associated fees regarding your child's removal from school.

You are keeping a school aged child whose parents reside elsewhere - (1302 Guardianship)

If you are keeping a school-age child in your home, whose parents or guardians reside elsewhere, you must complete and submit an Affidavit of Guardianship form before the start of each school year. This form constitutes a sworn statement that you are providing gratis support to the school-age child as if he/she was your own, and that the living arrangement is continuous and not just for the school year or solely for the purpose of attending school in Pottsville Area. If you have previously completed an Affidavit of Guardianship form, a new form will be mailed to you prior to the start of the school year. If you do not receive the form, please contact the Academic Center to make arrangements to receive a copy of the Affidavit of Guardianship. A new Affidavit of Guardianship must be completed each year for each child and submitted with three (3) proofs of residency. These forms must be signed and notarized in the presence of a Notary Public.

Failure to do so may result in your child's withdrawal from school and legal proceedings against you to recover tuition and other associated fees regarding your child's removal from school. In addition, any false information provided by you regarding residency could result in your personal liability for tuition and/ or criminal prosecution.



Verification of Residency and Eligibility for Educational Services

You are the parent/guardian of a school-age child and you and your child are living with a Pottsville School District resident

(including family member) (Multiple Occupancy)

If you are the parent or guardian of a school-aged child who attends public school in the Pottsville Area School District AND you are residing in the home of a Pottsville Area School District resident, including family members, you must complete a Multiple Occupancy Registration before the start of each school year. The Multiple Occupancy Registration process contains two affidavits: 1) an Application for Multiple Occupancy that is completed by the child's parent/guardian and 2) the Certificate of Multiple Occupancy that is completed by the PASD resident with whom you reside. A new Application for Multiple Occupancy and a Certificate of Multiple Occupancy form must be completed each year and submitted with three (3) proofs of residency. If you have previously completed an Application for Multiple Occupancy and a Certificate of Multiple Occupancy form, the forms will be mailed to you prior to the start of the school year. If you do not receive the forms, please contact the Academic Center to make arrangements to receive a copy of the Application for Multiple Occupancy and the Certificate of Multiple Occupancy forms. These forms must be signed and notarized in the presence of a Notary Public. Failure to do so may result in your child's withdrawal from school and legal proceedings against you to recover tuition and other associated fees regarding your child's removal from school. In addition, any false information provided by you regarding residency could result in your personal liability for tuition and / or criminal prosecution.

Acceptable proof of residency documents.

Parents/ Guardians must provide three (3) proofs of residency as follows: ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Original lease or deed signed by both parties
- Mortgage payment booklet
- Agreement of sale followed by original copy of settlement papers within 45 calendar days of settlement.
- Local Tax bill

TWO OF THE FOLLOWING PROOFS OF RESIDENCY:

- Sewer bill with current address
- Valid driver's license or change of address card with current address
- Valid vehicle owner's card with current address
- Utility bill within 30 days in your name with current address pay stub within 30 days with your name and current address
- Cell phone bill within 30 days in your name with current address



Administration Rule for the Processing of Truancy Citations & Referrals To Juvenile Court

Revised 5/2017

A) Procedures when a student is truant: The law defines "truant" as a student subject to Compulsory attendance who has three or more school days of unexcused absences during the current school year.

- Within 10 days of the student's third unexcused absence, the school will provide
 Written notification that the student has been truant to the person in parental
 relation to the student. The school may offer an attendance improvement
 conference.
- If the student continues to accumulate unexcused absences after the written notice is provided, the, school will convene a school attendance improvement conference. The school will invite the child, the person in parental relation to the child, other individuals identified by the person in parental relation who may be a resource, appropriate school personnel, and recommended service providers. The school will provide the parent with advance written notice of the meeting. The conference my occur if the parent declines to participate or fails to attend the scheduled conference after advance written notice and attempts to communicate via telephone. The school will complete a written "School Attendance Improvement Plan" to document the outcome of the conference.

B) Procedures when a student is habitually truant: The law defines "habitually truant" as six or more school days of unexcused absences during the current school year by a child subject to compulsory school attendance.

- When a child is habitually truant and under fifteen years of age at the time of the Referral: The school will refer the child to a school-based or community-based Attendance improvement program or to Schuylkill County Children and Youth "Services for services or for possible disposition as a dependent child. The school ...may file a citation in the office of the appropriate magisterial district judge against the person in parental rélation of the student.
- When a child is habitually truant and fifteen years of age or older at the time of the time of the referral: The school will refer the student to a school or community-based attendance improvement program or file a citation with a magisterial district judge. If the student continues to incur additional unexcused absences after being referred to a school attendance improvement program as recommended through the school attendance improvement conference, the school may refer the child to Schuylkill County Children and Youth Services.
