6016 Homebound Instruction

The school district may provide a student with instruction in thier home and under parent or guardian supervision if the student is physically or mentally ill or injured and unable to attend regular classes for an extended period of time. Homebound instruction shall be provided when the student's physical and mental condition are such that the student can benefit from instruction and no other provision will meet the student's educational needs. The superintendent or their designee will determine when homebound instruction is appropriate, after conferring with the student's parents or guardians, teacher(s) and/or physician.
