

COVID PROTOCOL UPDATE

Effective January 18, 2022 at 9:00 am CST Kansas Dept of Health and Environment has suspended Contact Tracing & Quarantine Efforts for the *Next 30 Days* due to a shortage of testing supplies with the high rate of Covid-Positive Cases.

We are asking families to follow the Guidance provided below regarding symptomatic students and known exposures.

I HAVE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID

- → Staff or Students Must Complete a Five (5) Day Isolation Period
- → Individuals May Return To School on Day Six (6) Under the Following Criteria:
 - No Covid Symptoms or Symptoms are Resolving
 - Fever Free for 24 Hours Without the Aid of Fever Reducing Medication
 - WELL-FITTING MASK REQUIRED FOR 5 ADDITIONAL DAYS at all times including sports and activities

I HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH A PERSON WITH COVID

- Families will Need to Monitor for Symptoms. If Symptoms Develop **PLEASE STAY HOME**
- → Optional On-Site Testing will Continue to be Available (with Completed Parent Consent Form for Students) as Long as Supplies are Available.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE BEST PRACTICES

- → If you are Feeling Unwell, PLEASE STAY HOME
- Social Distance as Best as Possible, Masks are Always Encouraged, and Maintain Good Hygiene Practices with Frequent Hand Washing and Sanitizing
