At Independence the team finished third with Zimmerman placing third and Becker finishing in sixth place.

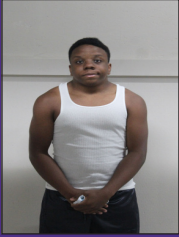
Then at Pittsburg the team placed third again with Becker placing third and Zimmerman placing fifth.
