Policy Statement

Parents, our goal is to provide a quality education for your child. Dress code violations have been a constant concern as well as a distraction. Please purchase school clothes based on the revised dress code. Students will be sent home or parents will need to bring appropriate clothing should a child not be appropriately dressed.

Bottoms

- No jeans/slacks/shorts/sweatpants/leggings shall have holes higher than 5 inches above the knees where skin is clearly visible beneath. This includes sheer/opaque material in leggings.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be a maximum of 5 inches above the knee.
- No undergarments can be visible at any time.
- No writing across the back of any type of bottoms is permitted.
- Jeans and pants must be appropriate size, no sagging.

Tops

- No sleeveless shirts are permitted.
- Hoodies and sweatshirts can be worn. (Hoods may not be on head during school).
- Logos and slogans can be worn that are not offensive or deemed inappropriate.
- No references to alcohol, sex, drugs, or profanity on tops or bottoms.
- No references that may discriminate against any race, creed, national origin, sex, age, religion or disability.
- No tops that show midriff

Coats/Jackets

- No trench coats are permitted.

Head Gear

- No sweatbands, hats, picks, visors, do rags, or bandanas can be worn.

Accessories

- No gang related attire is permitted such as raised pant legs and/or gang/cult symbols.
- No spiked accessories or chains such as attached to wallets are permitted.
- No sunglasses are permitted.
- When face masks are required (per school board policy/state mandates), masks must be cloth and cover nose and mouth at all times unless eating or drinking.
- No blankets

Students must adhere to dress code on field trips also.

The administrator will have the final discretion when dealing with a dress code issue.
