Guidance for Performance Levels and Points Based Grading System

Student performance is based on four Levels/Score Descriptors with the associated points:

Rubric Level/Score	Level/Score Descriptor
10-A	Above the Grade Level Standard The student demonstrates mastery of the standard above the grade level standard.
8.5–B	Meets the Grade Level Standard The student demonstrates knowledge of the standards at the grade level.
7.5–C	Approaching the Grade Level Standard The student demonstrates some knowledge of the standard at grade level and is making progress toward the standards.
6.5–D	Below the Grade Level Standard The student has not yet demonstrated sufficient understanding of the grade level standards.
5	Insufficient Data The student has attempted the work, but there is not sufficient evidence to determine an appropriate level of understanding
M	Missing The student has not completed or turned in the assignment
T	Turned In The student has turned in the assignment, but it will not count in the total points
Summative Tasks Summative tasks will have a multiplier of 5. This will give a higher weight to the summative task score than a formative assignment.
