Parking

All students who drive to school need a parking permit prior to the start of the school year and **no later than September 6th**. Students should park in the large parking lot west of the high school. The parking area in the front of the school is reserved for visitor and staff parking. The parking form is in Final Forms and must be completed to receive a permit. **Parking permits are \$8.**

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Area

Students who get dropped off or picked up before or after school should continue to use the designated area of the parking lot just west of the cafeteria. Entrance to this area is only accessible through Greenwood Heights Street. **For safety reasons, students should not be dropped off on North West Street, Moore Avenue, Huffman Street or Oakland Avenue.**
