Role of Board and Members (Powers, Purposes, Duties)

The Board of Education is the governing body of the school district and derives its power from and exists under the Constitution and General Statutes of the State of Connecticut and the regulations of the Connecticut State Board of Education. The Board of Education is governed by the City Charter.
