

## Grade 10 - eLearning - Day 1

The following eLearning assignments must be completed in all four core subject areas, including English, Math, Science, & Social Studies. Students are encouraged to contact their teachers for questions pertaining to each assignment.

### ELA

For this assignment, you will write a letter to your English teacher introducing yourself and sharing information that will help him/her get to know you better. Below are a list of questions that may give you some ideas:

- How do you feel about school? What are your hopes for this school year? What qualities have your BEST teachers in the past had?
- What are your talents? Tell me about the things that you're good at, that make you feel proud, and that you've accomplished in your life.
- Tell me about your family. How do you get along? Who are you closest to? What are unique things that your family likes to do or traditions you celebrate?
- What do you enjoy doing? What are your favorite foods, music artists, sports, celebrities, movies/shows, books, etc?

#### Requirements:

- Use letter format (greeting, body, closing)
- Minimum of 300 words

### Math

You want to determine the amount of rainfall, but you don't have a rain gauge. Develop your plan of action as to how you can do this, and explain how you would proceed. You may use drawings or any other visuals in addition to writing out your plan in detail. Make sure that your plan and written explanation are at least 250 words long. Be sure to include how you will verify the accuracy of your plan.

### Science

Do you think the smartphone is one of the most important inventions of the 21st century? Why or why not? Use your knowledge of persuasive writing to make your argument. You must have at least 300 words in your argument.

### Social Studies

Pick a significant historical event and write a diary entry as if you were a teenager living through the event. The diary entry should portray what you have witnessed during the event and how the event will impact your life and those close to you. The diary entry should be between 250-300 words.
