

LaSalle Academy Uniform Policy

2024-2025

Tops

- Shirts should be a solid color, black, red, white or gray and must cover the entire stomach, shoulder and back area.
- Polo/Oxford style with collar - Long or short sleeves
- Cardigan, crew neck sweater, crewneck sweatshirt, or sweater vest may be worn with a collared shirt underneath. These items must be black, red, white or gray and be a solid color. (7th and 8th-grade students may continue to wear navy, light blue, and yellow shirts for the remainder of the 2024-25 school year)
- Jackets of any type are not allowed to be worn during the school day. This includes fleece or track-style jackets.

Bottoms

- Bottoms should be solid color black, tan, or navy blue. Pants should be khaki style or dress slacks.
- Blue jeans, sweat pants, joggers/athletic style pants, and leggings are not acceptable. (Jeans may be worn on Fridays only with LaSalle spirit wear tops. Jeans cannot be ripped, patched, or stacked.)
- Pants should fit appropriately and not be too tight or overly baggy.
- Fishnet stockings and hosiery with decorative patterns are not allowed.
- Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be fingertip length or longer. Leggings worn underneath do not bring the length into compliance.
- Uniform shorts may be worn until Thanksgiving break and after spring break.

Student IDs

- A school-issued student ID must be worn on a breakaway lanyard around the neck at all times while in the building. Only (1) ID can be worn. Students cannot wear or possess a student ID that has been issued to another student.
- Incentive pins and honor roll pins received from LaSalle may be attached to the lanyard, but items such as toys, keychains, etc. are not to be worn on the lanyard.
- The student's face on the ID must be visible and not covered with stickers or permanent marker. If the marker or stickers cannot be removed, the student will have to purchase a new ID for \$5.00.

Accessories

- Chains, spikes, headbands with animal ears, or other novelty items may not be worn.
- Jewelry should not be excessive in nature.
- Hats, bandannas, wave setter caps, sweatbands, and/or hair nets are not to be worn inside the building or at school functions.

Footwear

- Secured to the foot with a strap on the back and/or laces tied.
- Shoes must have a sole.
- Slippers, flip flops, sandals, Crocs and Tasman Uggs are not permitted.

Spirit Wear

LaSalle spirit wear purchased from the school or an athletic/extracurricular group may be worn to school any day of the week. Spirit wear items must adhere to the uniform policy. Spirit wear t-shirts are the only non-collared shirt allowed.

SBCSC Dress Code

Uniform Policy: Any student attending a school that has adopted a school uniform policy will adhere to that school's clearly defined dress attire. Schools that adopt the uniform policy have surveyed their district members on this matter and have implemented the majority decision. Students transferring into the district or traveling between schools due to administrative purposes are not exempt from the uniform policy of the school. Any questions concerning the uniform policy should be directed to the building administrator.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. The responsibility for student dress is that of the students and the parents. The following guidelines should be followed:

1. Shorts-shorts must be worn at or below the knee, no exceptions. (Leggings are not a suitable substitute for pants and do not bring out of compliance shorts or skirts into compliance.)
2. Skirts-Skirts must be to the knee.
3. NO ragged, ripped, torn, or sheer items of clothing.
4. NO "Sagging"-shorts, slacks, jeans, etc., must fit properly at the waist. A belt must also be worn, if belt loops are present on the clothing item.
5. NO Pajama Pants or Tops.
6. NO tank tops (athletic or spaghetti strap styles), midriffs, shirts or tops that fail to cover the entire stomach or back area. Appropriate necklines should also be observed. Sleeveless tops must be three inches in width.
7. NO clothing, jewelry, hair styles, that exhibit anything related to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, gangs, cults, vulgar language, violent acts, or sexual innuendo.
8. NO hats, bandannas, wave setter caps, sweat bands, and/or hair nets are to be worn inside the building or at school functions.
9. NO unnatural hair colors-blue, green, bright red, pink, purple, etc.
10. NO Coats or outerwear clothing are to be worn in the classroom.
11. All School bags are to be put in the locker and not carried to class.

The administration reserves the right to make final judgment concerning the appropriateness of a student's attire/appearance.
