### MILITARY-BOUND

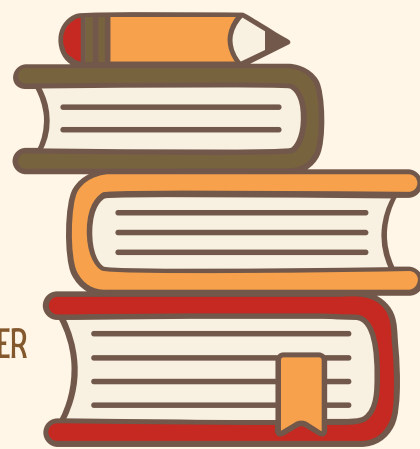
- STUDENTS SHOULD BE IN CONTACT WITH A RECRUITER

- ASKING QUESTIONS; AND FINALIZING PLANS.

### CAREER-BOUND

- STUDENTS SHOULD BE IN CONTACT WITH LOCAL/AREA TRADES SCHOOLS, VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS, OR APPRENTICESHIPS
- ASKING QUESTIONS ABOUT THE APPLICATION & INTERVIEW PROCESS; AND PREPARING SAID MATERIALS.

### GAP-YEAR

- STUDENTS SHOULD BE IN CONTACT WITH MS. KRUTSINGER OR MS. KOESTER WORKING TO DEFINE WHAT A GAP YEAR MEANS FOR THEM AND TALKING WITH PARENTS/GUARDIANS ABOUT SAID PLANS.
