- This virtual fair is an amazing way to learn more about college admissions, college options and more from the 300+ participating institutions.

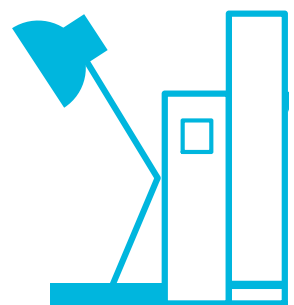
JUNIOR COURSE SELECTION RECAP
