The Brighton Student Nutrition Department welcomes you to a new, innovative concept of a food court. This is designed to offer faster service, ensure quality food, and meet the needs of all students. The computerized lunch program at Brighton Schools have been very successful. Benefits of this technology is the ability to process free and reduced meals with no discrimination; and to speed up the lines.

There are a few things you might like to know about this system.

- Every student has an account whether it is used or not.
- Money can be deposited at every location during lunch time at the Middle Schools and High School.
- In the Elementary Schools deposits are done as follows.

1. Your child will bring his/her lunch money in an envelope marked with his/her name and teacher's name on the outside. Also indicate the amount of money in the envelope on the outside. Please make out checks to B.A.S Cafe. Please pay weekly or monthly.

2. Students will have a place in their classrooms to drop off their money.

3. All money will be put into the child's account daily.

- At lunch time, students will feed their card through an electronic card reader, and the money will be deducted from their accounts.
- For your protection, students should use their cards, not just their account number!!
- Cash can still be used to purchase food items, but this will slow food lines.
