Greetings Maltby Parents,

We have had a great week here at Maltby Intermediate! Our 5th grade students will be taking their M-Step ELA tests starting next week. We are also having a wonderful time hosting all of our BAS 4th graders this week and next week so they can see our Encore classes first-hand before they make their choices. Our 5th and 6th graders will be starting their 4th quarter Encore classes next week on Tuesday (no school on Monday).

Middle School Math Information 2023:

For the majority of incoming 7th graders, the most developmentally appropriate math placement is Math 7. Then in 8th grade, students who have met the placement criteria will be invited to take High School Algebra 1. To ensure the most appropriate math placement for each student, multiple data points are used to determine which math course will best meet your student's needs. A small percentage of students may be ready to advance into High School Algebra 1 in 7th grade. To be certain that prerequisite understandings and skills are in place, an Algebra 1 Placement test will be administered to qualifying students.

- Due to the fact that any student taking High School Algebra 1 in 7th grade will be skipping two full years of foundational middle school mathematics, the criteria for the Algebra 1 Placement Test is very rigorous:
 - 1. Students must have earned an Advanced or Proficient score on the Quantile Benchmark (as measured by Imagine Math).
 - 2. Students must have also scored in the 90th percentile or higher on the nationally normed NWEA (Measure of Academic Progress).
- For students who meet the criteria, an invitation letter to take the Algebra 1 Placement test will be sent home on Friday, April 12, 2024.
- During the school day on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, the Algebra 1 Placement test will be administered by the BAS Administration and MIS teachers.







- 2. Select your fifth grader.

Michigan School Meals 2023-24


Brighton Area Schools will participate in the **Michigan School Meals Program** for the 2023-24 school year. **Michigan School Meals** is a state-funded program that provides reimbursement for meals, so all students receive the meals at no cost.

To participate, students just need to show up and take a qualified meal. A school lunch consists of five components: protein, grain, fruit, vegetable and fluid milk. For a lunch to qualify it must consist of a minimum of three of the five components and one of those must be a fruit or vegetable. Incomplete meals and individual meal components will be charged at a la carte pricing.

Families are strongly encouraged to complete the Application for School Meals. The number of eligible students helps secure additional funding for the District including Title I funding.

Students and families may qualify for other District program fee reductions based on their eligibility for free or reduced-price meals including SAT testing, pay to participate, and more.
