We Need More Parent Chaperones!!!!!

- Chaperones will be chosen via lottery in the event we have more volunteers than spots

Reproductive Health for 5th Grade Students...

Parent permission slips for our 5th grade reproductive health unit will be coming home in May. This unit is taught to our 5th grade students in late May/ early June and students are separated into boy and girl groups. We will be holding a virtual preview on May 19th at 7pm so parents can preview the videos in the event they would like to do so. We will send out a separate communication with that link. All of the teaching materials used in our reproductive health unit are approved by the district Health Advisory Committee.

Just a reminder to please be safe in the parking lot. Please DO NOT put your own need to hurry before the safety of our students in the morning and afternoon! We all need to work together and follow the traffic patterns to help keep kids safe. Dropping students off at areas other than the crosswalks or cutting through rows of parking are simply not acceptable. If your student is going to be absent from school, please use our convenient twenty-four-hour absence call-in line (810) 299-3688.

- Please obtain a doctor's note to receive a medically excused absence.
- Please call when your student will be coming in late.
- You must call in each day that your child is absent.
- Please call no later than 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence.
- Students arriving late to school should be dropped off at the flag pole door (Door # 1).
- Do not drive off until your student has rang the doorbell and is inside the building.



The McKinney Vento Act

The Brighton Area Schools is part of a consortium to serve students in temporary living situations that provides financial support for educational needs, referral for housing, clothing and other needs, general support and technical assistance. To ensure compliance with federal law, all school staff must help identify student living in the following situations: emergency shelters/transitional housing, motels/hotels, car, parks or public spaces, shared housing due to a loss of housing or economic hardship, or living temporarily with non-parent or guardian.

The district's homeless liaison is Starr Acromite and each building has trained staff members to assist in the endeavor. Our consortium contact at the Livingston Educational Service Agency is Candice Uyttendaele.
