### Messages for Students...

Parents please do your best to coordinate after-school arrangements with your child before they get to school. We are delivering an average of 10 messages a day to students at the end of the day which often means calling them out of class during what is already a busy time of the day. We certainly understand emergencies happen and students need to be notified of situations where they may need to be picked up vs. riding the bus and such. A great way to make sure your student knows the plan is to write it in your student's planner and review it with them in the morning. Our goal is the fewest interruptions possible to the school day. Again, we certainly understand that appointments and early dismissals are necessary, we just ask that we all do our best to avoid early dismissal if possible. Thank you for your cooperation and efforts in this regard!




## The PTO is a parent teacher organization where all Maltby parents are members. We welcome your ideas and participation!

## The McKinney Vento Act
