This year Maltby will again be using the Northwest Evaluation Association test for Measures of Academic Progress (MAP). This test will measure student growth in reading and math for our 5° and 6° graders. NWEA assessments will begin the week of October 11°.

If your student is going to be absent from school, please use our convenient twenty-four-hour absence call-in line (810) 299-3688.

- Please obtain a doctor's note to receive a medically excused absence.
- Please call when your student will be coming in late.
- You must call in each day that your child is absent.
- Please call no later than 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence.
- Students arriving late to school should be dropped off at the flag pole door.
- Do not drive off until your student has rang the doorbell and is inside the building.
- Students arriving late to school must report to the office to sign in. Parents do not need to come inside.
- Please send in a note for early dismissal and have it signed by office personnel.
- Please call when you arrive and we will send your student out. You do not need to come in.
- We will only allow students to be signed out by people who are listed on the emergency card.
- If you need an in-person meeting with a Principal or with staff, we ask that you please call and make an appointment.





Cell Phones at MIS

The McKinney Vento Act

The Brighton Area Schools is part of a consortium to serve students in temporary living situations that provides financial support for educational needs, referral for housing, clothing and other needs, general support and technical assistance. To ensure compliance with federal law, all school staff must help identify student living in the following situations: emergency shelters/transitional housing, motels/hotels, car, parks or public spaces, shared housing due to a loss of housing or economic hardship, or living temporarily with non-parent or guardian.

The district's homeless liaison is Starr Acromite and each building has trained staff members to assist in the endeavor. Our consortium contact at the Livingston Educational Service Agency is Candice Uyttendaele.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

This year, your child will be using Lexia® PowerUp Literacy®, a computer-based program that tailors instruction to their specific needs. The reading activities in PowerUp support and build on our English language arts classroom curriculum, focusing on three areas essential to becoming a proficient reader: word study, grammar, and comprehension.

Your reader began the PowerUp program at a starting point specific to his/her needs. The starting point is established from his/her performance on the placement assessment, which was completed earlier this year.

Every week, your student receives a log indicating the number of minutes needed to reach his/her weekly target, which is typically between 115-145 minutes/week. The weekly target can also be seen on the student dashboard when they login to PowerUp, which can be accessed through Clever.

The PowerUp program engages your student in online activities throughout the week in each of the three essential areas mentioned above. Online activities include direct instruction and immediate feedback as your reader learns new skills. Progress and performance are reported directly to teachers so extra help can be provided when needed.

This is a great program that has produced great outcomes, if students are putting in the time and effort needed. You can expect that your student will have the opportunity to access PowerUp lessons from school 30 minutes a week. Therefore, it's important for students to access this program at home in order to reach their weekly minutes and progress through the program learning the essential skills they need to become a proficient reader.

Here's how you can set your reader up for success:

- Students should complete the tasks on their own. That means no hints or tips from grown-ups, friends, or siblings! This is important because PowerUp provides extra support and instruction if students struggle with a task, and alerts teachers when further help is required.
- Try to provide a quiet space for learning. Students have found headphones to be useful in blocking out distractions and also for listening to directions, which are often provided auditorily.
- Encourage your reader to access PowerUp throughout the entire week. Completing the entire week's minutes
 in one or two days is not ideal, as too much time on educational software in one sitting can be
 counterproductive.
- You can encourage and celebrate your child's progress via the Your Progress tile found on the PowerUp student dashboard.

We hope you share in our excitement about this program!


