### **LABEL STUDENT'S PERSONAL ITEMS!**

We cannot stress enough the importance of having your student's personal items labeled with permanent marker. ### **IMPORTANT HEALTH INFORMATION!**

*Written authorization from a physician **is required** before school staff can dispense ANY medication (over the counter, homeopathic or prescription) to your son/daughter at school!*

- Instructions must be specific for medication, dosage, time to administer and for "as needed" meds, the frequency and circumstances under which to administer the medication.
- Medication must be provided in the original prescription or manufacturer's container.
- Parents can come and administer medication anytime to their student.

## **Attendance & Office Procedures**

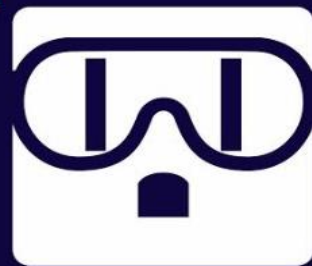
If your student is going to be absent from school please use our convenient twenty-four hour absence call-in line **(810) 299-3688**.

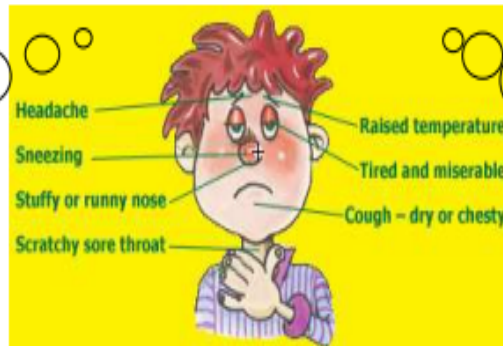

### Knowing the Difference... Can Make a Difference

The Cold and Influenza (flu) viruses have similar symptoms; so it can be difficult to know what illness someone has. Use the tips below for help.

SYMPTOMS	COLD	INFLUENZA (FLU) Seasonal and H1N1
Fever	Rare in adults and older children, but can be as high as 100 -102°F in young children & infants	Present, Often High, Usually 100°F and Over and Usually Lasts 3-4 Days
Headache	Rare	Very Common, Sudden onset and can be Severe
Body Aches	Slight	Very Common, Often Severe
Chills, Sweats	Uncommon	Fairly Common
Coughing	Hacking, Productive Cough	Dry, Unproductive Cough, Can be Severe
Sneezing	Very Common	Uncommon
Stuffy nose	Very Common	Less Common
Sore Throat	Common	Common
Chest Discomfort	Mild to Moderate	Often Severe
Tiredness	Mild	Sudden onset, Moderate to Severe
Symptoms	Develop Gradually	Develop Suddenly, Can Appear Within 3-6 Hours
Others		Some people may have vomiting & diarrhea

### WEEKLY SCHEDULE

**3<sup>rd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Tuesday, Thursday practices and games, some weekends for tournaments or mini Play Days. 8-10 league games plus 2-3 tournaments. Early Bird Registration fees are \$200 per player (not including uniforms for new players or those that have outgrown last year's jersey).

**5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Tuesday, Thursday and occasional Sunday practices. Saturday Skills Sessions (optional) at 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade levels. Most games will be Tuesday or Thursday, occasional Sundays + Saturdays for tournament play. Likely 12-15 games plus 3-4 tournaments. Early Bird Registration fees are \$250 per player (not including uniforms for new players or those that have outgrown last year's jersey).

**\*Uniform Note:** Brighton Girls Lacrosse program will have the same uniforms as last season to keep costs as low as possible. **If your player is new to the program or has outgrown their uniform from last season, you will need to purchase a new jersey from Kensington Valley Varsity.** Cost for the jersey is likely between \$45 - \$50, TBD by KVV. Please note that players are to wear black pants or shorts during games.
