#### IMPORTANT .. 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE PARENTS .. IMPORTANT

For all students entering the 7th grade, it is required by law that the school district report their immunization status to the local health department. With that being said, all children who attend school in Michigan are required by state law to be fully immunized to their standards. I have attached a document below that reviews Michigan's vaccination requirements for school. Please review your child's immunization status with their Physician as soon as possible to ensure compliance. Note that the Meningococcal and Tdap vaccinations are required for children 11 years of age or older upon entry into 7th grade. If you have a personal objection to immunizations, please contact the Livingston County Health Department ASAP to set up an appointment to obtain a certified immunization waiver, 517-546-9850. If your student is not fully immunized in accordance with the Michigan law OR does not have a certified immunization waiver on file by the first day of the 2019/2020 school year, they will be excluded from attending Scranton Middle School until compliance is met. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or to inquire about the current record of your student's immunization status. See flyer on page 4.

### VACCINES REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ENTRY IN MICHIGAN

Whenever children are brought into group settings, there is a chance for diseases to spread. Children must follow state vaccine laws in order to attend school. These laws are the minimum standard to help prevent disease outbreaks in school settings. The best way to protect your child from other serious diseases is to follow the recommended vaccination schedule at www.cdc.gov/vaccines. Talk to your health care provider to make sure your child is fully protected.

All doses of vaccines must be valid (correct spacing and ages) for school entry purposes.



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Dear Parent,

Brighton Area Schools has made arrangements again this year to acquire the GRASP program. GRASP is a nine-week correspondence program which helps students in grades K-8 maintain reading and math skills during summer vacation. It should take you and



your child approximately one hour a week to complete each weekly lesson. Because it is a correspondence program, it can accompany you on vacation. Lessons are completed and mailed to a scoring center where they are analyzed, then returned to you. Instruction sheets found in each packet provide all the necessary information.

The enrollment fee is \$38 for one subject and \$63 for both. You can enroll your child by completing the form below and paying the indicated enrollment fee or register online at BrightonCommunityEd.com, use CODE: GRASP K-3 and/or GRASP 4-8.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

This form and fee must be returned to Brighton Community Education NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, APRIL 12, 2019.

\*You must obtain teacher's approval if requesting packets other than your child's current grade. The form and the fee should be returned to the Community Education Office at 850 Spencer Road, Brighton, MI 48116, NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, APRIL 12, 2019. All materials will be sent home with the child on or before the last week of school. Please make checks payable to Brighton Community Education. Students should be enrolled in Math or Reading in the grade level being completed in the 2018–2019 school year.

\*Please note that the GRASP curriculum has been completely rewritten and updated to align with current state and national standards. The level of difficulty has increased but is grade appropriate.
